NOTICE OF APPLICATIONS

The Town of Georgina has received the following applications under the Planning Act:

South side of Old Homestead Road to the west side of The Queensway North, Keswick
Official Plan Amendment and Zoning By-law Amendment applications have been submitted to amend the Keswick Secondary Plan and Zoning By-law 500 in order to facilitate the severance of a lot containing an existing dwelling and accessory structures, and to receive relief from various other provisions applicable to the future development of the remainder and adjoining land parcels. The remainder land is proposed to be developed by plan of subdivision in the future in conjunction with the adjoining property to the east.

The Official Plan amendment application applies to two parcels of land, as illustrated on the Location Map. This amendment seeks to permit the creation of a 1.05 ha lot containing an existing dwelling (served by private well and septic disposal system) and accessory structures to remain privately serviced until such time as municipal water and sewer servicing is available, and to also prohibit development on the remainder parcel until these services are also available to these lands. The applicant is also seeking approval for the following: (1) to permit the transfer of residential density from the proposed lot containing the existing dwelling to the remainder parcel and adjoining lands combined (equivalent density of approximately 10 residential units) to allow additional residential units thereon at such time as a proposed plan of subdivision is submitted, and (ii) to exempt the remainder lands and the adjoining lands from the requirement of preparing a Development Area Plan as a prerequisite to subdivision approval on these parcels.

The Zoning Amendment Application applies to only one parcel of land, being the proposed 1.05 ha lot and the remainder land, and not on the adjoining property to the east. This amendment seeks to apply a Holding (H) zone to the property to prohibit further development until such time as both the dwelling and the proposed subdivision can be serviced with municipal water and sewers.

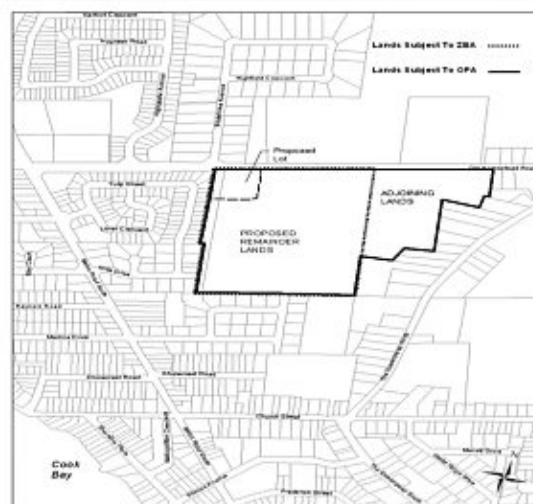
A Consent Application has been filed concurrently (assigned File Number: B5-13), to permit the creation of the 1.05 ha lot noted above, however, same will be held in abeyance pending consideration of the Official Plan and Zoning Amendment applications. Should the subject official plan amendment application be approved, applications for subdivision approval will then be filed with the Town.

The subject lands are described as Part of Lots 15 and 16, Concession 3 (NG) and Part of Former Road Allowance between Concessions 2 and 3 (NG). Additional information relating to the proposal is available for inspection at the Planning and Building Department from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on regular business days. A statutory public meeting will be scheduled and held at a later date, for which notice will be provided pursuant to the requirements of the Planning Act.

Your comments on these matters are important. Comments and opinions submitted will assist the Town in making informed recommendations and decisions on the relevant issues(s). Any comments or opinions submitted, including the originator's name and address, become part of the public record, may be viewed by the general public, and may be published in a Planning report and Council Agenda.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Georgina before the proposed by-law is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Council of the Town of Georgina to the Ontario Municipal Board, and the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
