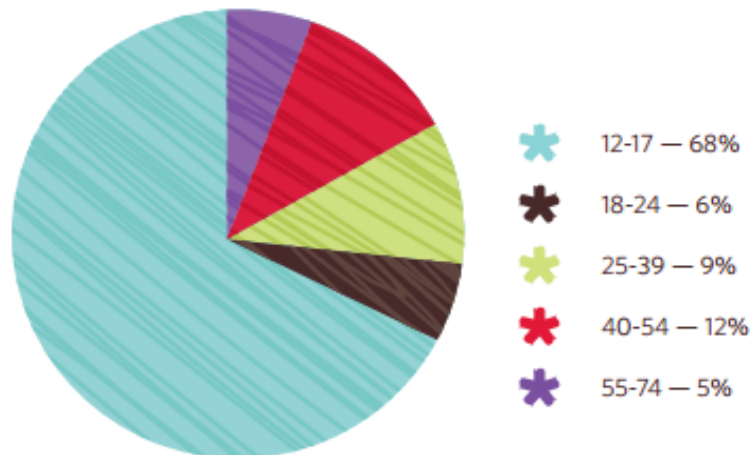

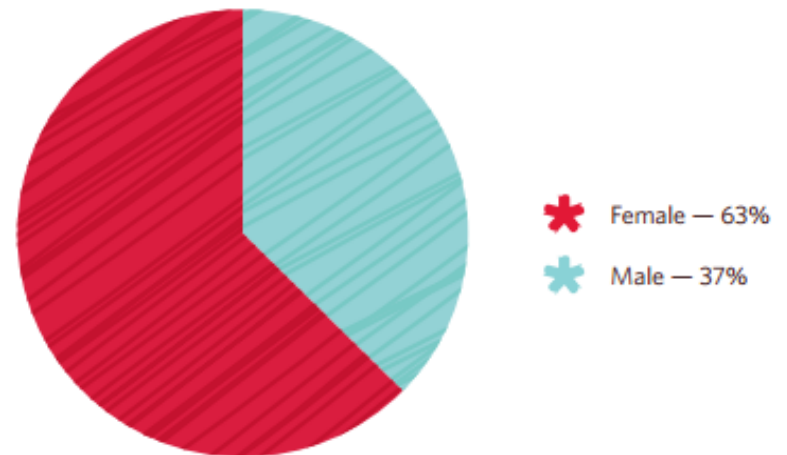
## VOLUNTEERS

At Neighbourhood Network, we have signed up over **4000 local volunteers** who support our communities in countless ways. Below is a snapshot of the volunteers in our Network.

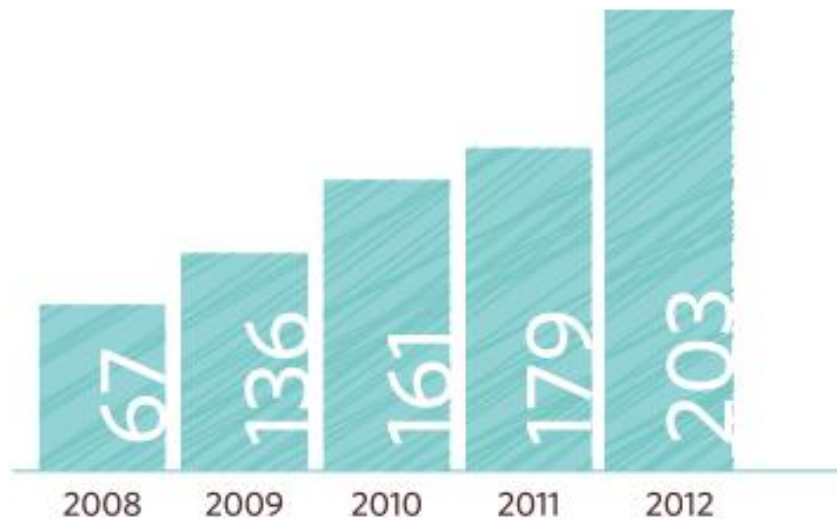


Percentage of Age
