Re: Installation of Traffic Signal in Connection with Proposed Construction of LCBO Retail Store Located at 20954 Dalton Road, Sutton, ON (Part of Lots 9, 10, 11, Block 60, Plan 69); Roll No. 080-873 (the "Shopping Centre").

Dear Mayor and Council:

Queen's Court Development Ltd. (formerly known as "Slate Master Holdco Ltd.") (the "Owner") intends to construct a LCBO store at the above-captioned Shopping Centre, presently occupied by Sobeys and Tim Hortons. The site plan application process and preliminary building permit review are currently underway.

As part of the project, the Owner engaged Cole Engineering ("Cole") to conduct a Signal Warrant Assessment (the "Assessment") to determine whether or not the addition of LCBO to the Shopping Centre would generate the incremental vehicular traffic to warrant the signalization of the intersection of Dalton Road and Woodriver Bend (the "Intersection"). The Assessment concluded that signalization was not warranted.

Despite the Assessment's findings, The Regional Municipality of York (the "Region"), in collaboration with the Town of Georgina (the "Town"), has required that the Owner undertake to signalize the intersection as a condition of site plan approval.

The Owner has spoken with Michael Baskerville, Town Engineering Manager, and it is requesting that the Town contribute twenty-five percent (25%) of the overall value of the signalization, estimated to be \$227,145.90. Detailed cost estimate and signal plans, as prepared by Cole, are also attached.

The signalization has many benefits to Town residents and Shopping Centre customers, including:

- Enhanced public safety, including the replacement of an existing pedestrian crosswalk on Dalton Road immediately north of Woodriver Bend; and,
- Improved traffic management, in conjunction with the relocation of the Shopping Centre driveway to align with Woodriver Bend.

The Region has indicated that it will contribute fifty percent (50%) of the overall signalization value. The Owner is committed to contributing the remaining twenty-five percent (25%).

The proposed traffic signal notwithstanding, as part of the project the Owner will be undertaking numerous improvements to the Shopping Centre including landscaping and lighting enhancements, the previously-mentioned driveway relocation and parking lot resurfacing.


We appreciate your consideration in this matter and look forward to your prompt response.

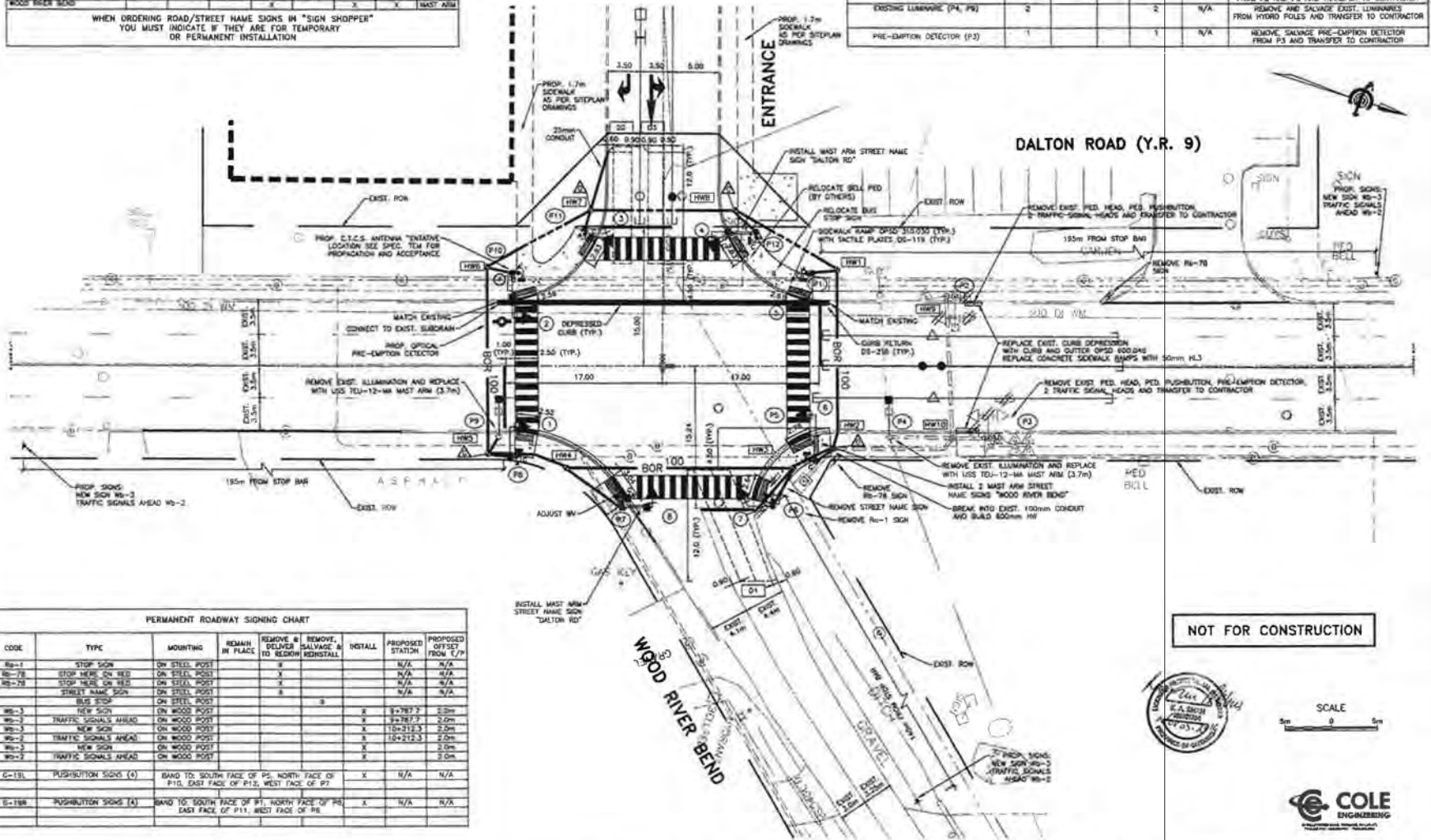

BY-LAW NO. 2015-0014 (COU-2)

BEING A BY-LAW TO CONFIRM THE PROCEEDINGS
OF THE COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON THE 28th DAY
OF JANUARY, 2015

WHEREAS under subsection 5(3) of the *Municipal Act, S.O. 2001*, chapter 25, as amended, the powers of a council of a municipal corporation shall be exercised by by-law;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the proceedings of the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Georgina at its meeting held on the 28th day of January, 2015 be confirmed and adopted by by-law.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Georgina, in the Regional Municipality of York, hereby enacts as follows:

1. The proceedings and actions of Council as contained in the Reports and Additional Business referred to in Schedule 'A' at the end of this by-law are adopted and confirmed as if each proceeding and action were expressly adopted and confirmed by by-law. As if all such proceedings were expressly embodied in this by-law.
2. Subject to section 3, the Mayor, any other appropriate member of Council and the proper Town officials be authorized and directed to undertake all actions necessary to give effect to the proceedings and directions of Council referred to in section 1.
3. Where a proceeding or action requires an additional approval to that of Council before a particular action can be done in order to give full effect to it, the Mayor, any other appropriate member of Council and the proper Town officials before taking the particular action under the authorization of section 2, shall seek and obtain the necessary additional approval and are authorized to do so.
4. A document required to be signed on behalf of the Town shall be signed by the Mayor or Deputy Mayor, Town Clerk or Deputy Clerk.

5. A Member of Council, whose name is set out in Column 1 of Schedule 'B', Conflict of Interest, at the end of this by-law, has declared an interest with respect to any item in Column 2 set out opposite the member's name, and the Member has declared an interest in this confirmatory by-law as it relates to the confirmation of the proceedings and actions on the item.
6. This by-law shall be signed by the Mayor and Clerk, affixed with the seal of the Corporation and engrossed in the By-law book.
