Hi. I'd like to follow-up on a conversation Margaret and I had the other day, regarding the possible formation of a Black River Residents Committee:

Our beautiful lakeside Municipality is also a river rich one with three navigable rivers; the Pefferlaw River, the Black River and the Maskinonge River, all within the boundaries of Georgina. A rather unique aspect of our community.

So, three rivers and Lake Simcoe... what I propose that we need (and I know there is interest and merit) is a Georgina Waterways Advisory Committee! To consider issues related to stewardship, safety, lake and river health, navigation, shared usage, tourism, etc.

Possibly comprised of 3 councillors(one from each Ward with a river), and 6 residents/business owners(one for each river and one for each area of lakefront, i.e. Keswick, Sutton/Jacksons Point and Pefferlaw)

Of course there would need to be at least one staff liason.

Total number of voting members would be nine.

Meetings could be to a max. of six or even four.

There would likely be the need for occasional collaboration with other committees (Environment, Agriculture even Heritage), but that's o.k..

I think we need too embrace the fact that we are what we are as a municipality, now and historically, largely because of Lake Simcoe and the rivers. Let's show that we get it! The creation of such a committee would be a shrewd move.
