NOTICE TO SIMCOE LANDING SUBDIVISION RESIDENTS

The Town of Georgina's "Winter Season" takes place from November 15, 2014 to March 15, 2015.

NEW Initiative: To assist in our winter operations it's kindly requested that all vehicles be parked 20 metres (66 feet) away from all intersections. All parking signs within intersections will be covered to remind residents of this NEW process. Cooperation in complying with these restrictions will greatly assist our Snow Plow Drivers in maintenance efforts and also help ensure proper visibility and sightlines at intersections.

SIMCOE LANDING ROADWAYS - WINTER PARKING RESTRICTIONS:

- EVEN house number parking is allowed from 9 a.m. on EVEN days to 9 a.m. on ODD days.
- ODD house number parking is allowed from 9 a.m. on ODD days to 9 a.m. on EVEN days.
- Please ensure vehicles are removed on time to allow for winter operations to proceed in a timely manner.
- *NEW* Initiative: When there is a forecast of 50mm (2 inches) of snow, it's kindly requested that vehicles refrain from parking on the street in case of a major snow event.

SNOW ACCUMULATION ON ROADWAYS:

- Firstly, an initial plowing pass is applied to all primary roads followed by all secondary roads.
- Primary roads connect to Regional roads and collect/carry traffic through from the secondary roads (i.e. Joe Dales Drive).
- Additional passes or changes to treatment responses may occur if Operations staff encounter severe winter events (possibly resulting in longer completion times). *Patience and co-operation from community members would be greatly appreciated in these circumstances.*

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

AN APPLICATION TO AMEND THE OFFICIAL PLAN AND CONTINUED CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATIONS FOR DRAFT PLAN OF SUBDIVISION APPROVAL AND ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Town of Georgina will be holding a Public Meeting on Wednesday, March 11, 2015, beginning at approximately 7:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Georgina Civic Centre at 26557 Civic Centre Road, Keswick, to consider an application to amend the Official Plan, pursuant to Section 22 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13, as amended, and continued consideration of applications for Draft Plan of Subdivision approval and Zoning By-law Amendment. Please note that these applications, along with other matters, will be dealt with in the order that they appear on the agenda or as Council may determine.

PROPOSAL:

A Statutory Public Meeting was held on September 10, 2014 on applications for subdivision and zoning amendment submitted by 739034 Ontario Inc., to permit the development of a plan of subdivision containing 40 dwelling units on the land described as Part of Lots 2 and 3, Concession 3 (NG), generally located on the east side of The Queensway South, and on the north side of Joe Dales Drive, in Keswick. As the proposal exceeded the permitted density of the Keswick Secondary Plan, the applicant has submitted an application for Official Plan Amendment (OPA) and also a revised Draft Plan of Subdivision which reduces the total number of dwelling units from 40 to 35. The proposed OPA seeks to recognize semi-detached dwelling units as a medium density housing form and to permit an increase in the allowable residential density from the permitted maximum average density.
