Dear Town of Georgina, I'm am writing you in concern of your proposal of zoning for cannabis production. I am concerned because you have not released a map of said proposed zoning due to "to many properties", this makes me feel that just about any property would be able to qualify for growing facility. I live and run a 100 acre farm outside of Udora we do crops and run a boarding facility. I have clients that come to the farm to use the facilities and the last thing they would want to smell is cannabis during their recreational time. This could result in loss of business, and in these times could be drastic to my farms income. I'm also concerned about your enforcement and regulation of these legal facilities, when currently There is a illegal cannabis operation With 400+ plants growing outside in the ground, less then 20 feet off my property line on the property next to mine. Less than 50 feet from my buildings. I have informed you the township. I have informed York Regional Police, but have not had any response. If nothing is done about illegal operations currently running right now in Georgina how can myself or the public have confidence that there would be any enforcement or regulations if you just let them become legal. I am opposed to the zoning of rural areas for cannabis production, and believe Georgina should be a No Cannabis Production, No Cannabis retail township. Thank you for your time Rob Cooper
