## By-law No 57 1898

A By Law to appropriate the sum of Four hundred and sixty Dollars for the improvement of Highways in the Township of Georgina

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina, That the sum of Four hundred and Sixty Dollars, be and is hereby appropriated from the General Funds of the Township for the improvement of the Public Highways in said Township, to as follows, and expended under the supervision of the under-mentioned persons as Commission, that is to say

The sum of \$100 be laid out on the 7<sup>th</sup> Con. Line as the Commission may decide and the Council be Commission for the same.

The sum of \$20.<sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub> be laid out on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Con. line near the East Bridge opposite Lot 20, and Michael Baker be Commission for the same.

The sum of \$20.<sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub> be laid out on the side line between 12 & 13 Con. 6 in opening a ditch and R. J. Kiddell be Commission for the same.

The sum of \$10.<sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub> be laid out on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Con. line opposite Lots 4 & 5, for the purpose of opening a ditch, and Frederick Hazelton be Commission for the same.

The sum of \$60.<sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub> be laid out to meet the Voted by the Township of Scott on the Town-line and Michael Baker be the Commission for the same.

The sum of \$60.<sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub> be laid out on the Hill Con 5 opposite Lot 6 and The Keene and R. J. Kiddell be Commission for the same.

The sum of \$30.<sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub> be laid out on the Town-line  
in front of 16 & 17 Con. 1. Providing the Township of Scott  
grant a similar sum, and Michael Baker be the  
Commission for the same.

The sum of \$25.<sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub> be laid out in opening a  
ditch on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Con. and Michael Baker be  
Commission for the same.

The sum of \$20.<sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub> be laid out on Con. 9  
near the Railway Crossing, and James Anderson  
be Commission for the same.

The sum of \$55.<sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub> be laid out on the 8<sup>th</sup>  
Con. line in Francis Holans Mead, and James  
Thornber be Commission for the same.

The sum of \$25.<sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub> be laid out in taking out  
stumps opposite Lots 17 & 18 on the 6<sup>th</sup> Con. line -

By Law No 38 1878

A By Law to define a load of gravel and size of Wagon box to be used for performing Statute Labor

The Council of the Corporation of the Township of Georgia enacts as follows:

1. That a load of gravel for a team and wagon shall be at least one square yard
2. That a load of gravel for a single horse and wagon shall be one half square yard
3. That a wagon box for a team shall be at least nine feet long 3 feet broad and 1 foot deep
4. That any person refusing to comply with this By Law shall be subject to the penalties in By Law No 232 for nonperformance of Statute Labor
5. That all By Law or parts of By Laws inconsistent with this By Law are hereby repealed

A By Law to appoint a person and place in each school section to take charge of and repair road scrapers

Be it enacted by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina

1 That each school section shall have a person and place appointed to take charge of and repair road scrapers

2 The following named persons and places are hereby appointed in each school section.

No 1 Henry Treloar Sutton

No 2 John Elves Lot 13. Con. 6.

No 3 John Gates Lot 7 Con 3

No 4 George Francis Pefferlaw

No 5 John Fraser Uctora

3 The Caretakers shall have the general charge and repairing of the road scrapers in their respective divisions.

4 They shall not receive any remuneration for such charge

5 Be it further enacted that any ratepayer or path-master not returning a road scraper to the Caretaker that he may have received, shall be liable to the same penalty as is prescribed for refusal or neglect to perform statute labor

6 The Caretaker shall make a report yearly to the Clerk of the Municipality by the first of May showing the number and state of repairs of all Road scrapers in his division

7 All By Laws and parts of By Laws inconsistent with this By Law are hereby repealed

A By Law to provide for dividing the Township of Georgina into Polling Subdivisions

Pursuant to the provisions of Chap. 174 Sec. 461. sub. sec. 1 of the Consolidated Statutes of Ontario, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina enacts as follows:

- 4 No. 2 Polling subdivision shall consist of all land to the north of the 4<sup>th</sup> Con. line, and East of the side Road between Lots 6 & 7.
- 5 No. 3 Polling subdivision shall consist of all land to the south of the 4<sup>th</sup> Con. line, and East of the line between Lots 10 & 11

A By-Law to provide for the Conveyance to Robert Hutchinson of the Township of Utbridge in the County of Ontario of a piece of land in the Village of Sutton lying in front of the Block designated in the plan of said Village as "Market Square" and abutting on High Street

Whereas the said piece of land has been conveyed by John W. Donald of Sutton to the said Robert Hutchinson

And whereas the same has never been used or taken as a street or otherwise

Be it therefore enacted by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same.

That the said piece of land be conveyed to the said Robert Hutchinson which said piece of land is situate lying and being in the Village of Sutton in the Township of Georgina in the County of York and Province of Ontario and may be more particularly described as follows.
