Ty. Law No 49 . 1879

U. Ty. Law to make provisions for the Opening Improving and maintaining of the Road on the Townline East of the fifth and sixth concessions of the Township of Georgino.

1st Therefore be it enacted by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Georgino, and it is hereby enacted by the Authority of the same that the Township Line east of the fifth and sixth Concessions of the Township of Georgino by the passing of this Ty. Law to be open to the use of the Public's Travel on the first of September next.

2nd And as all persons interested is notified according to Law. Be it further enacted that every person or persons having enclosed or occupying any part or parts of the Township Line aforesaid (on Original allowance for Road) shall be required on or before the first of September 1879 to give up possession and open the same for the use of the Public Travel the same to be made by gratis or Statute Labor or otherwise as directed by the Council.

3rd And be it also enacted that Robert Dornell and Michael Baker be Commissioners with full power to carry this Ty. Law into force.

4th And further that all Ty. Laws or parts of Ty. Laws not in accordance with this Ty. Law be Repealed.

And whereas the amount of the existing debenture debt of the said Township of North Guilford is the sum of Twenty six thousand dollars and none of the principal and none of the interest is in arrears

And whereas there is no existing debenture debt of the said Union School Section

The Municipal Council of the Townships of Georgia enacts as follows:-

1921 V It shall and may be lawful for the Reeve of the said Township and he is hereby required to cause to be made debentures of the said Township to the amount of the said sum of Four thousand dollars in all in sums of not less than One hundred dollars each which debentures shall be sealed with the seal of the said Municipal Corporation and signed by the said Reeve and

That the sum of three hundred and fifty-dollars shall be raised in each year during the currency of the debt created by this B. Law for the payment of the several instalments of principal and interest accruing due on such debt as the same become respectively payable and the same shall be raised and levied in each year by a special rate sufficient therefor on all the rotatable property in the said Union School Section.

This B. Law shall take effect on the fifteenth day of November 1879

That B. Law number fifty seven of the said Township passed for the purpose of authorizing the issue of the same amount of Debentures for the same purpose be and the same hereby is repealed doubt having been expressed as to the validity of the said B. Law

- 1 That the said Township of Georgina shall be and is hereby divided into four Polling Subdivisions
- 2 The boundaries of the said Subdivisions shall be and the same are hereby declared to be as follows
- 3 No. 1 Polling Subdivision shall comprise Cons. 5 from Lot 1 to 4 inclusive, also Cons. 6, 7, 8 & 9 from Lots 1 to 12 inclusive
- 4 No. 2 Polling Subdivision shall comprise Cons. 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 & 9 from Lots 13 to 25 inclusive
- 5 No. 3 Polling Subdivisions shall comprise Cons. 1, 2 & 3 from Lots 15 to 25 inclusive
