 each to the satisfaction of the Council
 also to receive all moneys belonging to
 the Municipality from whatever source
 derived also pay the same on the duly
 executed order of the Keere or otherwise
 provided by law and that for the due
 performance of the duties of said Office
 he shall be paid the annual salary
 of forty Dollars

3rd That George Johnson and Alexander
 Williams be and are hereby appointed
 Auditors for the current year, and that
 for the due performance of their duties

They shall be paid the sum of three dollars each.

4th That Donald McDonald be and is hereby appointed Assessor and that for the due performance of his duties as such he shall be paid the sum of Fifty Dollars

5th That John Evans be and is hereby appointed Collector, whose duty shall be to deposit with the Council a Bond duly executed by himself and two good and sufficient Sureties, himself in the sum of Eight thousand Dollars, and his Sureties in the sum of Four thousand Dollars each, the salary to be thirty five dollars
