A By-Law of the Municipal Council of the Municipality of the Township of Georgina for Closing up Mill Street in the Village of Udora in the Township of Georgina, and also those portions of York ~~Street~~ Street extending westwards from Victoria Street, and eastwards from Village Lot number Twelve in said Village of Udora, and in lieu thereof for opening up a street extending from the Town-line separating the Townships of Scott and Georgina, to said York Street through and over Village lots number Eleven and Twelve.
