By-Law number 9 for the year 1883.

A By-Law to License Regulate and Govern Transient Traders.

Whereas the Consolidated Municipal Act 1883 empowers Municipal Councils in Townships to enact By-Laws for Licensing Regulating and Governing Transient Traders.

1st Be it therefore enacted by the Corporation of the Township of Georgina and it is hereby enacted by the authority aforesaid that Transient Traders and other persons who occupy premises within the Township of Georgina for temporary periods and whose names have not been duly entered on the Assessment Roll in respect of income or personal property for the then current year, shall before offering goods or merchandise of any description for sale by auction or otherwise take out a license therefor from the Treasurer of this Municipality and he is hereby authorized to issue the same provided always that this By-Law shall not apply or restrict the sale of the stock of an Insolvent Estate which is being sold or disposed of within the County in which the Insolvent carried on business therewith at the time of the issue of a writ of attachment or of the execution of an assignment.

2nd Be it further enacted that such Transient Traders or other persons as aforesaid requiring a license under the provisions of this By-Law shall pay therefor the sum of Twenty Dollars.

3rd Be it further enacted that any person or persons contravening the provisions of this By-Law shall upon conviction before a Justice of the Peace having jurisdiction in this Municipality be liable to a fine of not less than Five Dollars or more than Twenty Dollars and in default of payment a distress warrant to issue against the goods and chattels of the offender and in default of distress to be imprisoned in the Common jail for a period of not less than Ten days.

4th Be it further enacted that all By-Laws or Parts of By-Laws inconsistent with the provisions of this By-Law be and the same are hereby repealed.

By-Law number 10 for the year 1883.

A By-Law for preventing regulating and licensing Exhibitions held or kept for hire or profit, Bowling Alleys and other places of amusement in the Municipality of Georgina.

Whereas under provisions of Chap 174 Section 461. and Sub-Sectors 29 & 30. of the Revised Statutes of Ontario. Power is given to Municipal Councils of Townships to prevent regulate and license Exhibitions held or kept for hire or profit Bowling Alleys and other places of amusement.

Be it enacted by the Corporation of the Township of Georgina and is hereby enacted under authority of the same.

1st. That any person or persons keeping or contracting for hire or profit or otherwise Exhibitions Bowling Alleys Shooting Galleries or other Places of amusement for gain shall before practising any of the above mentioned Callings take out a license therefor from the Treasurer of this Municipality who is hereby empowered to issue such.

2nd. Be it further enacted that any such person or persons obtaining license under the provisions of this By-Law pay therefor the sum of Twenty Dollars.

3rd Be it further enacted that any person or persons contravening the provisions of this By-Law shall upon conviction before a Justice of the Peace having jurisdiction in this Municipality be liable to a fine of not less than Five Dollars or more than Twenty Dollars, and in default of payment a distress warrant to issue against the goods and chattels of the offender and in default of distress to be imprisoned in the Common Jail for a period of not less than Ten days.

4th Be it further enacted that all By-Laws or Parts of By-Laws inconsistent with this By-Law be and the same are hereby repealed.
