By Law No 5 for the year 1884.

A By-law to provide and appoint Polling Places, and Deputy Returning Officers for the respective Polling Sub-Divisions in the Township of Georgia for the Municipal Election for the year 1885.

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgia, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same.

1st. That the Polling Place for Sub-Division No. 1. be at Sheppard's Hall in the Village of Sutton, and that Henry Treloar be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.

2nd. That the Polling Place for Sub-Division No. 2. be at the Pepperlaw Hall, and that George Johnson be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.

3rd. That the Polling Place for Sub-Division No. 3. be at the School House near Udora and that A. C. Brethour, be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.

4th. That the Polling Place for Sub-Division No. 4. be at Yates' Shop Egypt, and that John Yates be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.

5th That in the event of an Election being held the said Deputy Returning Officers shall be paid for their services, as such, the sum of Four Dollars each, and their respective Poll Clerks the sum of Two Dollars each.

Constables when employed the sum of One Dollar each and that the Reeve grant his order for payment of the same by the Treasurer on demand after the same has become due.

6th That all By-Laws or parts of By-Laws inconsistent with the provisions of this By-Law be and the same are hereby repealed.
