By-Law number 2 for the year 1885.

A By-Law to appoint a Board of Health for the Township of Georgina.

Whereas by the provisions contained in Sec. 12 of 47 Vic. Chap. 58. it is imperative upon Municipal Councils to appoint a Board of Health in every Municipality.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same that there shall be a Board of Health appointed for the Municipality of Georgina to consist of Messrs George Johnson R. A. Riddell and Henry Trelour together with the Reeve and Clerk of this Township who are ex officio members of such Board of Health as set forth in the Statute above referred to.

And be it further enacted that the duty of said Board of Health is more particularly set forth in the enactments contained in Schedule A appended to the above recited Act, or so much thereof as may be in force in this Municipality.

A By-law to fix the scale of Statute Labour assessment for the year 1885.

Be it enacted by the Council of the Corporation of Georgina, and it is hereby enacted by authority of the same, That the scale of Statute Labour Assessment be reduced to the extent of one third from the present assessment for the present year, and that when any fractional part less one half day takes place in making the said reduction the Clerk is hereby empowered to withhold such fractional part and not charge the same in making the Road Divisions Statute Labour Lists for the year 1885. and that all By-laws or parts of By-laws inconsistent with this By-law be and the same are hereby repealed.

By-Law number 6 for the year 1885.

A By-law to provide and appoint Polling Places and Deputy Returning Officers for the respective Polling Sub-Divisions in the Township of Georgina for the Municipal Election for the year 1886.

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,

1st That the Polling Place for Sub-Division No. 1 be at Sheppards Hall in the Village of Sutton and that [Name] be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.

2nd That the Polling Place for Sub-Division No. 2 be at the Pefferlaw Hall and that George Johnson be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.

3rd That the Polling Place for Sub-Division No. 3 be at the School House near Uxora and that Christopher Baynard be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.

4th That the Polling Place for Sub-Division No. 4 be at Yates Shop Egypt and that Jno. Yates be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.

That in the event of an Election being held the said Deputy Returning Officers shall be paid for their services as such the sum of Four Dollars each, and their respective Poll Clerks the sum of Two Dollars each. Constables when employed the sum of One Dollar each and that the Reeve grant his order for payment of the same by the Treasurer on demand after the same has become due.
