A By law to appoint Auditors of Township accounts - Assessor - Collector and a Board of Health for the Township of Georgina for the year 1889.

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same.

- 1st - That George Johnson be and is hereby appointed Auditor of Township accounts and the Reeve by virtue of his office appoints Wellington Wismer the other Auditor for the current year.
- 2nd - That W. H. Wilson be and is hereby appointed Assessor for the year 1889 and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties as such the sum of Seventy dollars per annum.
- 3rd - That Jno. P. Nelson be and is hereby appointed Collector for the current year and that he be paid for the due performance of the duty of said office the sum of fifty five dollars per annum.
- 4th - That George Johnson, J. G. Newayon and H. Shelton together with the Reeve and Clerk compose the Board of Health for the Township of Georgina for the year 1889 and that J. B. Beutley M.B. be and is hereby appointed Medical Health Officer and Jno. Byall Sanitary Inspector for the current year.

By Law number 3 for the year 1889.

A By law making provision for the sale of a portion of the 9th Con. line opposite lot 2 in the 8th Con. Township of Georgia.

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgia and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same

- 1st - That a portion of the 9th Con. line of the original road allowance where the same intersects that park sold and conveyed in the year 1876 to W. J. Ramsay & Co. by the Corporation of the Township of Georgia, commencing at high water mark and extending westward parallel with said concession line the distance of ninety five feet.
- 2nd - That adjoining said ninety five feet that the balance of said concession to where it intersects the Lake Shore Road where it turns off the 9th Con. line being in extent 66 feet by 260 feet be sold under the provision of Chap. 184, Sec. 546, A. S. O. 1887.
- 3rd - That all By laws or parts of By laws inconsistent with the provisions of this By law be and the same are hereby repealed.

A By-Law to provide for the levying and collecting of special rates for School Sections Nos. 1. 2. 3. 4. 5. 6 and Union School Section No 1 East Swillimbury. to defray the expenses of said schools for the year 1889 and for the payment of school section No 1. Debenture.

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgia and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same - That the following sums be levied and collected from the rateable property of the respective School Sections viz. Union School Section No 1. and 2. 3. 4. 5 & 6. also Union School Section No 1 East Swillimbury to defray the expenses of said School Sections for the current year, also a rate to redeem Union School Section No 1 Georgia Debenture to equal the sum of \$500.

By-law number 6 for the year 1889.

A By-law to confirm a certain agreement between the corporations of Georgina and that of the Township of Brock in reference to the amount of statute labour to be expended on the Townline between the respective municipalities

Be it enacted by the municipal Council of the Corporation of Georgina and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same.

1st That on and after the passing of this By-law the Corporation of the Township of Georgina shall annually appropriate a certain amount of statute labour for the improvement of the Townline between Georgina and Brock or its equivalent in cash at the rate of seventy five cents per day.

2nd That a commissioner be appointed to act in conjunction with a commissioner from the Township of Brock whose duty shall be to meet said commissioner on the first Monday in June in each and every year to arrange and regulate the expenditure of either statute labour or cash on said Townline in equal proportions to both municipalities on the basis set forth in the first clause of this By-law.

3rd That Donald Ego be and he is hereby

appointed said commissioner for the Township of Georgia and that he be paid for carrying out the provisions of this By-law the sum of two dollars per day for the time employed at such work and that all By-laws or parts of By-laws or Resolutions inconsistent with this By-law be and the same are hereby repealed.

By-law number 7 for the year 1889

A By-law to confirm the awards of Judge Morgan and warden Ramsden

Whereas the arbitrators to decide the amount of statute labour and money grants to be expended yearly by the Townships of Scott and Georgina on the Townline of said municipalities was convened at Uxora Village, Township of Scott on November 30th last and whereas the County Judge and Warden Ramsden of the County of York were present and the Warden of Ontario was absent,

and whereas the Chairman Judge Morgan did inform the representatives of both municipalities that the award would not be binding as no proof was to hand that the Warden of Ontario had received his notice.

and whereas a majority of each municipal Council were present and did determine and agree that they would bind themselves to abide by the award if the two arbitrators present would consent to take evidence and proceed as though all were present.

and whereas the two arbitrators present did agree to the above and whereas it is expedient to confirm the same therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina enacts as follows

A By-law to provide and appoint Polling Places and Deputy Returning Officers for the Respective polling Sub-Divisions in the Township of Georgina for the Municipal Election of the year 1890.

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same.

- 1st That the Polling Place for Sub. Division No 1. shall be at Sheppard's Hall in the Village of Sutton and that Henry Ingham be and is hereby appointed Dep. Returning Officer
- 2nd That the Polling Place for Sub. Division No 2 shall be at the Pefferlaw Hall and that George Johnson be and is hereby appointed Dep. Returning Officer.
- 3rd That the Polling Place for Sub. Division No 3 shall be at the School House near Udora and that Robert Brethour be and is hereby appointed Dep. Returning Officer
- 4th That the Polling Place for Sub. Division No 4 shall be at the Methodist Meeting House Egypt and that William Stratton be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.

5th. That in the event of an Election being held the said Deputy Returning Officers shall be paid for their services as such the sum of Four Dollars each and their respective Poll Clerks the sum of Two Dollars each, Constables when employed the sum of one Dollar and Fifty Cents each.

6th. That all By-laws or parts of By-laws inconsistent with the provisions of this By-law be and the same are hereby repealed.
