A By-law to appoint auditors of Township accounts, Assessor and a Board of Health for the Township of Georgina for the year 1890.

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same

1<sup>st</sup> That George Johnson be and he is hereby appointed Auditor of township accounts and the Board by virtue of his office appoints F. G. Fremayne the other auditor for the current year.

2<sup>nd</sup> That Donald Ego be and is hereby appointed to the office of Assessor for the year 1890 and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties as such the sum of \$65.00 per annum.

3<sup>rd</sup> That Henry Trelour, F. G. Fremayne & Geo. Johnson together with the Reeve and Clerk compose the Board of Health for the Township of Georgina for the year 1890 and that T. B. Bentley M.D. be and is hereby appointed Medical Health Officer and Geo. Byall Sanitary Inspector for the current year.

By-law number 2 for the year 1890

A By-law to appoint a Director to represent the Township of Georgina on the Board of Directors of the Lake Simcoe Junction Railway Company.

Whereas power is given in the Statutes of Ontario 36 Vic. Chap. 75 Sec. 20 an act to incorporate the Lake Simcoe Junction Railway Co. That whenever any municipality shall take stock, grant a bonus or otherwise aid the said Company to an amount not less than Twenty thousand dollars. The Council of such Municipality shall be entitled to name a director of the said company as the representative of such Municipality and whereas the Municipality of the Township of Georgina have given aid to the said company by granting a bonus of twenty thousand dollars in aid of the construction of said Railway.

Be it therefore enacted by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same that James Anderson be and is hereby appointed Director to represent this Municipality on the Board of Directors of the said Company and shall continue to be such Director until his successor be appointed according to law and shall be possessed of all the powers and privileges equal to any Director of the said Company

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same.

1<sup>st</sup> That the Polling Place for Sub. Div. No. 1. outside the limits of the incorporated Village of Tipton shall be at the School House at Virginia and that John P. E. be and he is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.

2<sup>nd</sup> That the Polling Place for Sub. Div. No. 2 shall be at the Pepperlaw Hall and that George Johnson be and he is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.

3<sup>rd</sup> That the Polling Place for Sub. Div. No. 3. shall be at the School House near Urdora and that Robert Brethour be and he is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.

4<sup>th</sup> That the Polling Place for Sub. Div No 4. shall be at the School House in Egypt. and That William E. Johnson be and he is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.

5<sup>th</sup> That in the event of an election being held the said Deputy Returning Officers shall be paid for their services as such the sum of Four Dollars each and their respective Poll Clerks the sum of Two Dollars each and Constables when employed the sum of one Dollar and Fifty Cents each.

6<sup>th</sup> That all By-laws or Parts of By-laws inconsistent with the provisions of this By-law be and the same are hereby repealed.
