A By Law To provide for a place for holding the Nominating Polling places and the appointment of Deputy Returning officers for the respective Polling sub Divisions in the Township of Georgina for the Municipal Election of 1892.

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina

- 1st That the nomination for the year 1892 be held at the Pefferlaw Hall in the Township of Georgina.
- 2nd That the Polling place for sub-Div. No 1 outside the limits of the Incorporated Village of Sutton be at the School House at Virginia and that John P. Lago be and he is hereby appointed Deputy Returning officer.
- 3rd That the Polling place for sub-Div. No 2 shall be at the Pefferlaw Hall and that George Johnson be and he is hereby appointed Deputy Returning officer.
- 4th That the polling place for sub-Div. No 3 shall be at the School House near the Village of Udora, and that Robert Brethour be and he is hereby appointed Deputy Returning officer.
- 5th That the Polling place for sub-Div. No 4 shall be at Mr. Gates house in Eggleston and that John Gates be and he is hereby appointed Deputy Returning officer.
