A By law to appoint Auditors of Township accounts, Assessor, Collector Clerk and Treasurer, also a Board of Health for the Township of Georgina for the year 1893.

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina,

1st That George Johnson be and he is hereby appointed auditors of Township accounts and the Reeve by virtue of his office appoints John W. Davies the other auditor for the year 1893, and said auditors shall be paid the sum of \$4 per annum for the due performance of the duties of said office.

2nd That Wm E. Donlinson be and he is hereby appointed Assessor for the year 1893 and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties as such the sum of \$50 per annum.

3rd That Joseph S. Key be and he is hereby appointed to the office of Collector for the year 1893, and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties the sum of \$42 per annum.

4th That Augusto Lugo be and he is hereby appointed Township Clerk and that he be paid for his duties as such the sum of \$100 per annum.

5th That George Evans ^{Jr.} be and he is hereby appointed Treasurer and that he be paid for his duties as such the sum of \$45 per annum.

6th That Jas J. Graham, George Johnson and R. A. Riddale together with the Reeve and Clerk do compose the Board of Health for the Township of Georgina for the year 1893.

By-Law number 3 for the year 1893.

A By-Law to provide for the levying of County and Township rates, the payment of common school Teachers, County and Township Railway Debentures likewise the expenses of the Industrial Home, and the levying of a general rate on the assessment of the Townships for the non-residence school sections therein with the exception of that part connected with the incorporated Village of Sutton being No. 1, Gargrave, for the year 1893.

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Gargrave, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the following rates be levied and collected from the taxable property of the Township of Gargrave by Tax County and Township purposes, for the payment of common School Teachers, and for the redemption of County and Township Railway Debentures, the expenses of the Industrial Home, and the proportion to the several school sections in the Township less from that part of school section No. 1, connected with the incorporated Village of Sutton, also the proportion to the Breckhill school section for the year 1893.

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina and it is hereby enacted by the Authority of the same, That the following sums and rates be levied and collected from the real estate property of the respective School Sections and in Union School Section No 7 East Gwillimbury and Nos 1. 2. 3. 4. 5 and to Township of Georgina to defray the expenses of said school sections for the current year, a rate to redeem School Section Debentures for No 1 Georgina to equal the sum of \$350.

By-Law No 19 for the year 1893.

A By-Law making provisions for a place to hold the nomination of Reeve, Deputy Reeve and Councillors, for the Township of Georgina also Polling places and the appointment of Deputy Returning Officers

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina

1st. That the nomination for the year 1894 be held at the Pefferlaw Hall in the said Township of Georgina

2nd. That the Polling place for Sub-Div. No 1. be at the School house Virginia, and that Donald Ego be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer,

3rd. That the Polling place for Sub-Div. No 2. be at the Pefferlaw Hall Pefferlaw, and that George Johnson be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer,

4th. That the Polling place for Sub-Div. No 3. be at the School house near Adora, and that Christopher Raynard, be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer,

5th. That the Polling place for Sub-Div. No 4 be at Yates House, and that John Yates be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.

6th, That in the event of a Municipal election being held together with the Prohibition Plebiscite Act vote, the said Deputy Returning Officers shall be paid for their services as such the sum of four dollars each, and their Poll Clerks the sum of two dollars each, and Constables when employed the sum of one dollar and fifty cents each.

7th, That all By Laws inconsistent with the provisions of this By-Law be and the same are hereby repealed,-
