A By law to appoint Auditors of Township accounts, Assessor, Collector, Clerk and Treasurer, also a Board of Health for the Township of Georgia for the year 1893.

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgia,

1<sup>st</sup> That George Johnson be and he is hereby appointed Auditor of Township accounts and the Reeve by virtue of his office appoints John M. Davies the other Auditor for the year 1893, and said Auditors shall be paid the sum of \$4 per annum for the due performance of the duties of said office.

2<sup>nd</sup> That Wm E. Tomlinson be and he is hereby appointed Assessor for the year 1893 and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties as such the sum of \$50 per annum.

3<sup>rd</sup> That Joseph S. Hay be and he is hereby appointed to the office of Collector for the year 1893, and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties the sum of \$42 per annum.

4<sup>th</sup> That Augus Ego be and he is hereby appointed Township Clerk and that he be paid for his duties as such the sum of \$100 per annum.

5<sup>th</sup> That George Evans<sup>r</sup> be and he is hereby appointed Treasurer and that he be paid for his duties as such the sum of \$45 per annum.

6<sup>th</sup> That Jno J. Graham, George Johnson and R. A. Riddle together with the Reeve and Clerk do compose the Board of Health for the Township of Georgia for the year 1893.

By-Law number 3 for the year 1893.

A By Law to provide for the levying of County and Township rates, the payment of Common School Teachers, County and Township Railway Debentures likewise the expenses of the Industrial Home, and the levying of a general rate on the assessment of the Township for the respective school sections therein with the exception of that part connected with the incorporated Village of Sutton being Vol. Georgia, for the year 1893.

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgia, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that the following rates be levied and collected from the taxable property of the Township of Georgia viz for County and Township purposes, for the payment of common School Teachers, and for the redemption of County and Township Railway Debentures, the expenses of the Industrial Home, and the proportion to the several school sections in the Township, less for that part of school section No 1 connected with the incorporated Village of Sutton, also the proportion to the Breanhill School section for the year 1893.

## By-Law No 19 for the year 1893.

A By-Law making provisions for a place to hold the nomination of Reeve, Deputy Reeve and Councillors, for the Township of Georgina also Polling places and the appointment of Deputy Returning Officers

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina

- 1<sup>st</sup> That the nomination for the year 1894 be held at the Pefferlaw Hall in the said Township of Georgina
- 2<sup>nd</sup> That the Polling place for Sub. Div. No 1. be at the School house Virginia, and that Donald Ego be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer,
- 3<sup>rd</sup> That the Polling place for Sub Div. No 2. be at the Pefferlaw Hall Pefferlaw, and that George Johnson be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
- 4<sup>th</sup> That the Polling place for Sub Div. No 3. be at the School house near Udora, and that Christopher Raymond, be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer,
- 5<sup>th</sup> That the Polling place for Sub Div. No 4 be at Yates House, and that John Yates be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.

6<sup>th</sup> That in the event of a Municipal election being held together with the Prohibition Plebiscite Act vote, the said Deputy Returning Officers shall be paid for their services as such the sum of four Dollars each, and their Poll clerks the sum of two Dollars each, and Constables when employed the sum of one Dollar and fifty cents each.

7<sup>th</sup> That all By-Laws inconsistent with the provisions of this By-Law be and the same are hereby repealed, -
