A By-Law to appoint Auditors, Assessor, Collector, member of the Board of Health and Medical Health Officer for the Township of Georgina for the year 1900.

The Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows,

- 1st That Geo A. Corner and John M. Davies be and are hereby appointed auditors of Township accounts; and that they be paid the sum of \$6.00 each for the due performance of the duties of said officers.
- 2nd That Wm E. Zomlinson be and is hereby appointed assessor, and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties as such the sum of \$50.00.
- 3rd That Joseph S. Kay be and is hereby appointed collector, and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties as such the sum of \$40.00.
- 4th That James Cornwall be and is hereby appointed member of the Board of Health for the next ensuing term.
- 5th That G. J. Hobble be and is hereby appointed medical health officer for this municipality.
- 6th That all By-laws inconsistent with the provisions of this By-law be and the same are hereby repealed.

By-Law No. 3, 1900

A By-law to confirm an agreement re maintenance of boundary line between the townships of Scott and Georgina.

Whereas power is given to municipal councils to enter into agreements re maintenance of boundary lines,

And whereas an agreement dated the first day of May 1900, has been entered into by the representatives of the municipality of the Township of Scott in the County of Ontario, and of the municipality of the Township of Georgina in the County of York, in regard to the maintenance of the boundary line between said municipalities,

And whereas it is necessary that such agreements be confirmed by By-law of the Councils of the municipalities concerned,

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows,

1st That said agreement which is hereto annexed and marked Schedule A, be and is hereby confirmed, and shall be read as part of section one of this By-law,

2nd That Donald Ego Clerk or his successor in office be and is hereby appointed Commissioner for the purpose of seeing to the proper expenditure of Georgina's portion thereof, said Commissioner to report annually to this Council at the last-regular meeting in each and every year, as to the total expenditure on said boundary line for the then current year, and also report from time to time as to the state of repair of said line of roadway,

3rd That all By-laws or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this By-law be and the same are hereby repealed.—

Schedule A, to above By-Law

This agreement entered into this first day of May 1900, between the Councils of the Corporations of the Township of Scott in the County of Ontario, and of the Township of Georgina in the County of York, in respect to building and keeping in repair suitable for public travel the boundary line between said municipalities.

Said municipality agrees to expend in money and statute labor the sum of \$100- per annum on the following basis, which shall be each municipality shall pay in cash \$50- and \$20- in statute labor, the labor to be valued at fifty cents per day, And if either of said municipalities expend a greater number of days of statute labor than fifty in any one year, then said municipality shall be allowed out of its cash grant of \$50- the sum of 50cts per day for each such day in excess, but and if either of said municipalities is in default any portion of said statute labor, said defaulting municipality shall pay in cash for the improvement of said road the sum of 50cts per day for every such day in default;

This agreement commences on from and after the date above mentioned & continues for and during the term of Ten years.—

County Rate = 1 $\frac{8}{10}$ mills on the Dollar
 Township Rate = 1 $\frac{8}{10}$ mills on the Dollar
 Industrial Home = $\frac{4}{10}$ mill on the Dollar
 $\frac{3}{10}$ Grant to Schools
 except S. S. No 1 = 1 $\frac{1}{10}$ mills on the Dollar.

 S. S. No 5 = 2 " " " \$, S. S. No 6 = 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " " " \$,
 Union S. S. No 7 = 6 " " " \$, S. S. No 8 = 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " " " \$.

A By Law to appoint a place and time for holding nomination, also Polling places and Deputy Returning officers for the Municipal election Township of Georgina January 7th, 1901,

The Council of the Township of Georgina in

the County of York enacts as follows.

- 1st. That the nomination meeting for the year 1901, be held at the Pefferlaw Hall between the hours of one and two o'clock in the afternoon,
- 2nd. That the Polling place for Polling Sub Division No 1, be at Methodist Hall Virginia, and that George Evans be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer,
- 3rd. That the Polling place for Polling Sub Division No 2, be at the Pefferlaw Hall, and that Henry Corner be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer,
- 4th. That the Polling place for Polling Sub Division No 3, be at the School House Udoa, and that Christopher Rynard be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer,
- 5th. That the Polling place for Polling sub Division No 4, be at Stallions Hall Egypt, and that W. E. Tomlinson be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer,
- 6th. That in the event of an election being held that the said Deputy Returning officers shall be paid for their services the sum of \$4.00 each, and their respective Roll clerks the sum of \$2.00 each, and Constables when employed the sum of \$1.00 each, and that all By-Laws inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, —
