- 1<sup>st</sup>. That John M. Davies and George A. Connor be and are hereby appointed Auditors of townships accounts; and that they be paid the sum of \$6.00 each, for the due performance of their duties as such,
- 2<sup>nd</sup>. That W. E. Tomlinson be and is hereby appointed Assessor, and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties as such the sum of \$50.00,
- 3<sup>rd</sup>. That Joseph S. Kay be and is hereby appointed Collector, and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties as such the sum of \$42.00,
- 4<sup>th</sup>. That Charles Galbraith be and is hereby appointed Member of the Board of Health for the next ensuing term,
- 5<sup>th</sup>. That C. Y. Hoble Jr be and is hereby appointed Medical Health Officer for this Municipality;

County Rate = 2 mills on the Dollar

By-Law No 13,

A By-Law to provide for the levying of special Rate for the various School Sections Township of Georgina for the year 1901.

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina that the following special rates be levied and collected from the ratable property of the respective School Sections to defray the expenses of said Sections for 1901.

Union S.S. No 1 =  $4\frac{7}{10}$  mills on the \$, S.S. No 2 = 1 mill on the \$,

S.S. No 3 =  $4\frac{1}{10}$  mills on the \$, S.S. No 4 =  $2\frac{7}{10}$  mills on the \$,

S.S. No 5 =  $2\frac{7}{10}$  mills on the \$, S.S. No 6 =  $3\frac{1}{2}$  mills on the \$,

S.S. No 7 = 6 mills on the \$. S.S. No 8 = 3 mills on the \$.

By-Law No 14

A By-Law to appoint a place and time for holding nomination, also polling places and Deputy Returning Officers for the Municipal election Township of Georgina January 6<sup>th</sup> 1902,

- The Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows
- 1<sup>st</sup> That the nomination meeting for the year 1902 be held at the Pefferlaw Hall between the hours of one and two o'clock in the afternoon,
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> That the Polling place for Polling Division No 1 be at the Methodist Hall Virginia and that George Evans be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer,
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> That the Polling place for Polling Division No 2, be at the Hall Pefferlaw, and that Henry Connor be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer,
  - 4<sup>th</sup> That the Polling place for Polling Division No 3, be at the School House Udoza, and that Christopher Rynard be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer,
  - 5<sup>th</sup> That the Polling place for Polling Division No 4 be at Station Hall Egypt and that William E. Tomlinson be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer,
  - 6<sup>th</sup> That in the event of an election being held that the said Deputy Returning Officers shall be paid for their services as such the sum of \$4.<sup>00</sup> each, and their respective poll clerks the sum of \$2.<sup>00</sup> each, and Constables when employed the sum of \$1.<sup>00</sup> each, and that all By-Laws inconsistent with the provisions of this By-Law be and the same are hereby repealed,

## By-Law No 15

A By-Law to provide for the payment of certain Township officers for the year 1901,

The Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows.

1<sup>st</sup> That the undermentioned Township officers shall be paid the amount set opposite their respective names as remuneration for their services for the year 1901,

Councillors each per day the sum of \$2.00

Committee men each per day the sum of 2.<sup>50</sup>

Commissioners each per day the sum of 2.<sup>50</sup>

Members Board of Health per day the sum of 2.<sup>50</sup>

Selectors of Juries each per day the sum of 2.<sup>50</sup>

2<sup>nd</sup> That the Reeve grant his orders in accordance with the provisions of this By-Law, and that all By-laws or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this By-law, be and the same are hereby repealed.
