A By-Law to appoint certain Township officers for the Municipality of the Township of Georgina

The Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows

1<sup>st</sup> That Donald Ego be and is hereby appointed Township Clerk, and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties as such the sum of \$100.00 per annum,

2<sup>nd</sup> That George Evans be and is hereby appointed Treasurer, whose duty shall be to deposit with the Council a Bond to the extent of Three Thousand Dollars duly executed by himself and two good and efficient sureties to be approved of by the Council, and to receive all monies belonging to the Municipality from whatsoever source derived, also to pay the same on the duly executed order of the Reeve or as otherwise provided by Statute, and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties the sum of \$45.00 per annum,

3<sup>rd</sup> That <sup>Dr.</sup> G. J. Hoble Jr be and is hereby appointed Medical Health Officer, and that he be paid the ordinary medical fees for the time actually and necessarily employed in the faithful discharge of his duties as Medical Health Officer of this Municipality;

4<sup>o</sup> That E. G. Corner be and is hereby appointed Sanitary Inspector, whose duty shall be that whenever he becomes aware of the existence of any nuisance dangerous to the public health to immediately proceed to have the same removed or abated according to the provisions of the Public Health Act being Chapter 248 R. S. O. 1897, He shall also perform such other duties as may from time to time be assigned to him by the Board of Health or its Chairman, and for the due performance of all or any duties to the office of Sanitary Inspector for this Municipality he shall be paid the sum of \$3.00 for each and every day so employed,

5<sup>o</sup> That all By-laws or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this By-law be and the same are hereby repealed,

## By-Law No 22

A By-Law to provide for the payment of a Bonus in certain cases for the building of wire fences along the Highways in the Township of Georgina

Whereas the drifting of the roads by snow in the winter season seriously impedes public travel and it bring a source of great expense to keep the same open therefor

And whereas it is deemed expedient that a bonus should be paid for the erection and maintenance of wire fences on the lines bordering on the public highway of the Municipality adjacent to those places where snow usually drifts

Therefore be it enacted by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina in the County of York

1<sup>st</sup> That out of the Township funds of this Municipality a bonus of Twenty cents per rod be paid for the construction and maintenance of wire fences on the boundary lines of the public highway at such points as are subject to drifting by snow to such an extent as to impede & stop public travel thereon,

2<sup>nd</sup> That no such bonus will be paid to any person until such person deposits with the Council a certificate signed by at least Ten Ratepayers residing within the polling division in which said fence is erected certifying

that said fence is along a portion of the highway that is usually blocked in the winter season by snow drifts; and also that the fence so erected will be the means of preventing the drifting thereof,

3<sup>rd</sup> No such bonus will be paid to any person unless they enter into a covenant with the Corporation to maintain the fence so constructed and not to change it for any other than a wire fence having the approval of the Council,

4<sup>th</sup> No such bonus will be paid until fence is completed nor for any except standard woven or grip lock varieties and strung on posts planted not more than thirty feet apart with sound anchor posts properly braced and set not less than three feet in the ground, and to be inspected by one or more members of Council or by some Commissioner appointed by Council for that purpose,

- 1<sup>st</sup> That the nomination meeting for the year 1903 be held at the Pefferlaw Hall between the hours of one and two o'clock in the afternoon,
- 2<sup>nd</sup> That the polling place for polling division No 1, be at the Methodist Hall Virginia, and that George Evans be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer,
- 3<sup>rd</sup> That the polling place for polling division No 2 be at the Pefferlaw Hall Pefferlaw, and that Henry Corner be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer,
- 4<sup>th</sup> That the polling place for polling division No 3 be at School House near Uldora, and that Christopher Reynard be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer,
- 5<sup>th</sup> That the polling place for polling division No 4 be at Station Hall Egypt, and that W. E. Tomlinson be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
- 6<sup>th</sup> That in the event of an election being held that the said Deputy Returning Officers shall be paid for their services as such the sum of \$4.00 each, and their respective poll clerks the sum of \$2.00 each, and constables \$1.00 each, and that all By-Laws inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed,
