- 1st That the Nomination meeting for the year 1904 be held at the Pefferlaw Hall between the hours of one and two o'clock in the afternoon,
- 2nd That the polling place for polling division No 1, be at Methodist Hall Virginia, and that George Evans be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer,
- 3rd That the polling place for polling division No 2, be at Pefferlaw Hall Pefferlaw, and that Henry Corner be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer,
- 4th That the polling place for polling division No 3 be at the School House Adora, and that Christopher Rynard be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer,
- 5th That the polling place for polling division No 4 be at Station Hall Egypt and that W. E. Tomlinson be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer,
- 6th That in the event of an election being held that the said Deputy Returning Officers shall be paid for their services as such the sum of \$4.⁰⁰/₁₀₀ each, and their respective poll clerks the sum of \$2.⁰⁰/₁₀₀ each, and Constables when employed the sum of \$1.⁰⁰/₁₀₀ each, and that all By-laws inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed,
