By-law No 43

A By-law to provide for the payment of a bonus for erecting wire fences along the highways in the Township of Georgina

Whereas it is deemed expedient that a bonus should be paid for the erection of wire fences on the lines bordering on the public highways of this Township,

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enact as follows,

- 1st That out of the Township funds of this Municipality - that a bonus of 15 cents per rod be paid for the construction of wire fences on the boundary lines of the public highways,
- 2nd That no such bonus shall be paid to any person until such person deposits with the Council a certificate signed by at least Ten Ratepayers resident within the polling Division in which such fence is erected, certifying that such fence is along the boundary line of the highway, and also certifying that said fence is of either the standard woven or grip lock varieties and strung on posts planted not more than thirty feet apart and set not less than three feet in the ground,
- 3rd That By-law No 22 and all other By-laws or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this By-law be and the same is hereby repealed,

By-law No 45-

A By-law to appoint a place and hour for holding nomination, also polling places and Deputy-Returning officers for the Municipal Election of Jan 3rd 1905;

The Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows

- 1st That the nomination meeting for 1905 be held at the Pefferlaw Hall between the hours of one and two o'clock in the afternoon,
- 2nd That the polling place for division No 1. be at the Methodist Hall Virginia, and that George Evans be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer,
- 3rd That the polling place for ~~for~~ division No 2. be at the Hall Pefferlaw, and that Henry Corner be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer,
- 4th That the polling place for division No 3, be at the School House Udora, and that Chris. Reynard be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer
- 5th That the polling place for division No 4. be at Stallons Hall Egypt; and that W. E. Tomlinson be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer,
- 6: That in the event of an election being held that the said Deputy Returning Officers shall be paid for their services as such the sum of \$4.⁰⁰ each, and their respective poll clerks the sum of \$2.⁰⁰ each, and Constables when employed the sum of \$1.⁰⁰ each, and that all By-laws or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this By-law be and the same are hereby repealed,
