- 1st That John M. Davies and George A. Corner be and are hereby appointed Auditors of Township accounts, and that they be paid for the due performance of their duties as such the sum of \$7.⁰⁰ each,
- 2nd That W. E. Tomlinson be and is hereby appointed assessor, and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties as such the sum of \$60.⁰⁰,
- 3rd That Joseph S. Kay be and is hereby appointed Collector of Taxes, and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties as such the sum of \$45.⁰⁰
- 4th That John S. Graham be and is hereby appointed member of the Board of Health for the next ensuing term

A By-Law to appoint a place and hour for holding nomination also polling places and Deputy Returning officers for the Municipal Election of Jan 1st 1906

The Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows.

- 1st That the nomination meeting for 1906 be held at the Pefferlaw Hall on Friday Dec 22nd between the hours of one and two o'clock in the afternoon.
- 2nd That the polling place for Division No 1 be at the Methodist Hall Virginia and that Wm. C. Evans be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
- 3rd That the polling place for Division No 2 be at the Pefferlaw Hall, and that Arney Corner be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
- 4th That the polling place for Division No 3 be at the Udora School House, and that Christopher Rynard be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
- 5th That the polling place for Division No 4 be at Stallons Hall Egypt, and that W. C. Tomlinson be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
- 6th That in the event of an election being held that the said Deputy Returning Officers shall be paid for their services as such the sum of \$4.⁰⁰ each, and poll clerks the sum of \$2.⁰⁰ each, and Constables when employed the sum of \$1.⁰⁰ each, and that all By-Laws inconsistent herewith be and the same is hereby repealed.

2nd That the Reeve grant his orders on the Treasurer in accordance with the provisions of this By-law, and that all By-laws inconsistent herewith be and the same is hereby repealed,
