- 2<sup>nd</sup> That W. E. Tomlinson be and is hereby appointed assessor, and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties as such the sum of \$60.00,
- 3<sup>rd</sup> That Joseph S. Kay be and is hereby appointed Collector of Taxes, and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties as such the sum of \$45.00
4. That John S. Graham be and is hereby appointed Member of the Board of Health for the next ensuing term
5. That all By-Laws or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this By-Law be and the same are hereby repealed,

## By-Law No 54

A By-Law to appoint a place and hour for holding Nomination also polling places and Deputy Returning Officers for the Municipal Election of Jan 1<sup>st</sup> 1906

The Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows.

- 1<sup>st</sup> That the Nomination meeting for 1906 be held at the Pefferlaw Hall on Friday Dec 22<sup>nd</sup> between the hours of one and two o'clock in the afternoon.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> That the polling place for Division No 1 be at the Methodist Hall Virginia and that Wm L. Evans be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> That the polling place for Division No 2 be at the Pefferlaw Hall, and that Henry Conner be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
- 4<sup>th</sup> That the polling place for Division No 3 be at the Udoa School House, and that Christopher Rynard be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
- 5<sup>th</sup> That the polling place for Division No 4 be at Stations Hall Egypt, and that W. E. Williamson be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
- 6<sup>th</sup> That in the event of an election being held that the said Deputy Returning Officers shall be paid for their services as such the sum of \$4.<sup>00</sup> each, and Poll Clerks the sum of \$2.<sup>00</sup> each, and Constables when employed the sum of \$1.<sup>00</sup> each, and that all By-Laws inconsistent herewith be and the same is hereby repealed.
