By-Law No 62.

A By-Law to appoint a place and hour for holding Nomination, also polling places and Deputy-Returning Officers for the Municipal election of January 7, 1907.

The Council of The Township of Georgina in the County of York, enacts as follows.

- 1st That the Nomination Meeting for 1907 be held at the Pefferlaw Hall on Monday Dec 31st 1906, between the hours of One and Two o'clock in the afternoon.
- 2nd That the Polling Place for Division No 1 be at the Methodist Hall, Virginia, and that W. C. Evans be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
- 3rd That the Polling Place for Division No 2 be at the Pefferlaw Hall and that Henry Corner be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
- 4th That the Polling Place for Division No 3 be at the School-House near Udosha, and that Christopher Rynard be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
- 5th That the Polling Place for Division No 4 be at Stations Hall Egypt and that W. S. Tomlinson be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
- 6th That in case of an election being held that the said Deputy Returning Officer's shall be paid for their services as such the sum of $\$4^{00}$ each, and Poll-Clerks as such the sum of $\$2^{00}$ each, and Constables when Employed the sum of $\$1^{00}$ each, and that all By-Laws inconsistent herewith be and the same is hereby repealed, passed Dec 15, 1906.
