A By-Law to grant permission to the Sunderland Telephone Co. to plant their poles and string their wires along the highway's of this Municipality.

The Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows.

1<sup>st</sup>. That the Sunderland Telephone Co be and are hereby granted permission to plant their poles and string their wires along.

the Highways of this Municipality providing they ~~they~~ Comply with the conditions of the Second Clause of this By-Law.

2<sup>nd</sup> All poles to be of first class Material and not less than four inches in diameter at tops end when the wires is strung the same to be Seventeen feet clear of the ground, Poles to be planted not more than six feet from the Boundary of the roadway, and in no case are they to be planted in any ditch or Water-course, or in any Driveway to or from any Public or Private Property, and in ~~case~~ <sup>place where</sup> there are shade trees growing along the side or along the line of the roadway then the consent of the Overseer of the Road Division must be obtained as to where poles are to ~~plant~~ <sup>be placed</sup>.

By-Law No 77.

A By-Law to provide for the payment of a bonus for the erection of Wire Fences along the Boundary Lines of the Highways in the Township of Georgina.

The Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows.

1<sup>st</sup> That out of the Township funds of this Municipality that a bonus of Fifteen Cents per rod be paid for the construction of Wire Fences along the boundary lines of the Public Highways.

2<sup>nd</sup> That no such bonus shall be paid to any Person until such person deposits with the Council a certificate signed by at least Ten Ratepayers resident within the Polling Division in which such fence is erected certifying that such fence is along the Boundary Line of the Highway, and also certifying that such fence is of either the Standard Woven or Grip Lock variety and strung on Posts planted not more than thirty feet apart and set not less than three feet in the ground.

3<sup>rd</sup> That no such bonus shall be paid unless all the logs, rubbish and brush laying between such fence and

the travelled portion of the Roadway be picked up & burned, and any person applying for any such bonus must certify that said roadway has been so cleaned up as specified by this clause.

4<sup>th</sup> That no such bonus shall be paid for the erection of a wire fence along the boundary line of any untravelled highway, but when the same becomes a travelled roadway then the owner of said fence may apply for a bonus providing said fence is at said date in good condition.

5<sup>th</sup> That all By-Laws or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this By-Law be and the same are hereby repealed.
