By-Law No 91

A By-Law to provide for the muzzling of Dogs, and to make provisions for carrying out of the Order regarding Rabies

The Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows.

1st That all Dogs or Bitches owned or harbored in the Township of Georgina shall be either changed up or kept under lock & key in an out-house or be efficiently muzzled with metallic Muzzles satisfactory to the Inspector of the Department of Agriculture of the Dominion of Canada.

2nd That W. N. Ego, E. G. Comer, Frank Harvey & W. G. And be and are hereby appointed in their respective polling Divisions to enforce the provisions of this By-Law.

3rd That any Dog or Dogs found running loose after this By-Law comes into force without being muzzled shall be killed and Destroyed.

4th That this By-Law shall come into force on Tuesday March 1st 1910 and shall remain in force until the regulations re Rabies are withdrawn by the Government.

A By-Law to restrain and prohibit certain animals from running at large upon certain highways in the Township of Georgina from the 15th day of May to the 15th day of September.

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina that from and after the passing of this By-Law, that from the 15th day of May until the 15th day of September in each and every year that the following animals shall be restrained and prohibited from running at large upon that portion of the Highway along the Lakeshore from the Grand Trunk Crossing near Jacksons Point eastwards and South to the Small Bridge crossing the Creek below the gravel Hill south of the Stone Church, viz Horses, Cattle, Sheep and Pigs.
