By-Law No 116

A By-Law to authorize the issue and sale of Debentures for the sum of four thousand five hundred dollars, for the erection of a School House in School-Section number two of the Township of Georgia

Whereas the board of School Trustees of the said section have applied to the Council to raise the sum of four thousand five hundred dollars, by a loan upon the Debentures of the said Corporation extending over a period of twenty years, and repayable by equal annual instalments of principal and interest and

whereas for the payment of said debt and interest the respective sums hereinafter set forth will be required to be raised annually by a special rate over and above all other rates in each of the years during the currency of the said Debentures upon the rateable property of the public School Supporters of the said School-Section and

Whereas the proposed loan has been submitted to and sanctioned by a special meeting of the rate-payers of the said School-Section and

Whereas the amount of the whole rateable property of the said School-Section is according to the last revised Assessment roll Two Hundred & Seventeen Thousand Nine Hundred dollars and

Whereas the said School-Section has no existing Debenture Debt and

Whereas the amount of the whole rateable property of the Township of Georgia is according to the last-revised Assessment roll Nine Hundred and Twelve Thousand dollars and

Whereas the said Township of Georgia has no existing Debenture Debt:

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgia in the County of York enacts as follows:

1st- That the sum of Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500) so required by the Board of Trustees of School-Section number Two, be raised by the issue of Debentures as hereinafter mentioned and that the proceeds of said Debentures be paid to the Treasurer of the said Public School Board for the purpose herein before mentioned.

2nd- That for the purpose of effecting such a loan as aforesaid it shall be lawful for the Reeve of the Township of Georgia to issue or cause to be issued Debentures for sums not less than one hundred dollars and not exceeding in the total amount Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars, the same to be sealed with the Corporation Seal of the said Municipality, and to be signed by the Reeve and counter signed by the Treasurer of the said Municipality, which Debentures shall be marked and known as Public School Debentures.

3rd- That the whole of the Principal of the said Debt shall be repayable within a period of Twenty years and that the total amount required to be raised annually by a special rate for the paying of said Debt and Interest shall be the sum of Three Hundred and Sixty one Dollars and nine cents (\$361.09) computed as follows.

That for the purpose of providing a Fund for the payment of said Principal and Interest due from year to year as such Debentures mature there shall be raised and levied in each and every year during the said period of Twenty years on all the rateable property of the Public School Supporters of said School Section Number two by a special rate over and above all other rates a sufficient sum as respectively herebefore mentioned and set out in said Schedule for the payment of each instalment of principal and Interest; and the said sum to be raised and levied in the years set opposite amounts as hereinbefore mentioned in the said Schedule

By-Law No 120.

A By-Law to provide for borrowing money by the issue and sale of Debentures for the purpose of constructing Bridges on the Highways within the Municipality of the Township of Georgia.

Whereas several Bridges on the Highways within the Municipality of the Township of Georgia have become out of repair and are dangerous to Public Traffic and owing to the action of the recent floods some Bridges are completely destroyed.

and whereas it is deemed advisable to replace said Bridges by good and permanent structures, and for that purpose it will be necessary to raise the sum of three thousand five hundred Dollars (\$3,500.00)

And whereas the total amount required to be raised annually for the payment of said Debt and interest over and above all other rates and assessments amounts to \$453.27

And whereas the amount of the whole Rateable Property of the Corporation of the

Township of Georgina according to the last revised Assessment Roll amounts to the sum of \$912,600.00.

And Whereas the amount of the existing Debenture Debt of the said Corporation is \$4,500.00 School Debentures S. S. No 2.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows.

1st

That it shall be lawful for the Reeve of the said Municipality, and he is hereby authorized for the purpose aforesaid to borrow the sum of \$3,500.00, and to issue Debentures under the seal of the said Corporation to the amount of \$3,500.00 in sums of not less than \$100, each payable within a period of Ten years with interest at Five per cent per annum, in equal annual instalments of Principal and Interest, as set forth in the schedule hereto.

2nd

That said Debentures shall be sealed with the seal of the said Corporation and shall be signed by the Reeve and Treasurer thereof and shall be known and marked Bridge Debentures.

3rd

That the said Debentures shall be payable at the Metropolitan Bank Sutton on the days and time herein set out.

4th

That for the payment of said Debentures from year to year as they mature, there shall be raised and levied in each and every year during the said period of Ten years, on all the rateable property of the said Municipality in addition to all other rates the sum of \$453.27 being a sum sufficient to pay the several instalments of Principal and Interest accruing due on said Debt as provided in the following Schedule.
