By-law No 129

A By-law to provide for taking the votes of the electors on a proposed By-law Number 128 of the Corporation of the Township of Georgia to prohibit the sale by retail of spirituous, fermented or other manufactured liquors in the Municipality of the Township of Georgia, Passed the First day of Nov. A. D. 1913.

Whereas a proposed By-law of the Corporation of the Township of Georgia entitled a By-law to prohibit the sale by retail of spirituous fermented or other manufactured liquors in the Municipality of the Township of Georgia requires for its validity the assent of the electors and it is expedient and necessary to pass this By-law for the purpose of enabling the electors to vote on the proposed By-law,

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgia

The votes of the electors of the Corporation of the Township of Georgia shall be taken upon the said proposed By-law at the same time and at the same places as the annual election for the Municipal Council, and the Deputy Returning Officers appointed to hold said election shall take the vote

On the 27. day of December A. D. 1913. at the hour of two o'clock in the afternoon the head of the Council of the said Corporation or some member of said Council appointed for that purpose by resolution shall attend at the Clerk's office in the said Municipality for the purpose of appointing and if requested so to do shall appoint by writing signed by him two persons to attend at the final summoning up of the votes by the Clerk and one person to attend at each polling place on behalf of the interested in and promoting the proposed By-law and a like number on behalf of the persons interested in and opposing the said By-law.

On the 7th day of January A. D. 1914 at the hour of two o'clock in the afternoon at the Clerk's office in the said Municipality, the Clerk of the said

municipality shall attend and sum up the votes given for and against the proposed By-law.

4th That the Polling Booth for Div No 3 be at Stattons Hall Egypt and that John Ridehall be the Deputy-Returning Officer and Robert Jardine Jr. Poll Clerk.

5th That the Polling Booth for Div No 3 be at the School House Uclora and that W. J. Snodden be the Deputy Returning Officer and Joe W. Westgarth Poll Clerk.

6th That the above Deputy Returning Officers shall be paid for their services as such the sum of \$4⁰⁰ each and the said Poll Clerks the sum of \$2⁰⁰ each and Constables \$1⁰⁰ each

By-law No 132

A By-law to authorize and empower the Reeve and Treasurer, of the Township of Georgia in the County of York, to borrow funds to meet current expenditure.

Whereas it is necessary to borrow funds to meet current expenditure until the Taxes of 1914 are collected or until some other satisfactory arrangement can be made.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgia in the County of York.

1st That the Reeve and Treasurer of the said Corporation be and they are hereby authorized to borrow from the Standard Bank of Canada, or any other chartered Bank, by way of overdraft or otherwise, such sums as may be required from

time to time to meet current expenditures but not to exceed Two Thousand Dollars.

2nd

That an agreement sealed with the corporate seal and signed by the Reeve and Treasurer providing for the borrowing of such sums as may be required and the payment of the same with interest thereon as agreed upon, shall be executed and given to the said Bank as security for the repayment of the amount so borrowed with interest thereon as aforesaid.
