A By-law to appoint Auditors, Assessor, Collector, and members of the Board of Health for the Township of Georgia for the year 1917.

The Municipal Council of the Township of Georgia in the County of York enacts as follows.

1st That Jos. W. Westgarth and Charles Anderson be and are hereby appointed Auditors of Township accounts, and that they be paid for the due performance of their duties the sum of \$ 7⁰⁰ each.

2nd That Wilnot Riddell be and is hereby appointed Assessor, and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties as such the sum of \$ 6⁰⁰.

3rd That John Evans be and is hereby appointed Collector of Taxes, and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties as such the sum of \$ 6⁵⁰.

4th That Richard Cronsberry, Dr Boynton and Donald Ego be and are hereby appointed a Board of Health for the Township of Georgia for the year 1917.

5^m That all By-laws or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this By-law be and the same are hereby repealed.

By-law No 162.

A By-law to appoint appraisers to value Sheep killed or injured by Dogs

Whereas chapter 246 R. S. C. 1914 and amendments thereto requires Township Councils to compensate the owners of Sheep, to the full value of the damage done by Dogs, where the owner of such Dogs cannot be found, and

Whereas it is incumbent on Municipal Councils to thoroughly investigate all applications for damages under the above act, and to fully satisfy themselves of the loss actually sustained by the parties thus applying and

Whereas provisions is made in said Act for the appointment of appraisers for the purpose of better arriving at the value of the Sheep so killed or injured,

121 Therefore the Council of the Township of Georgia in the County of York, enacts that the following named persons (and their successors in office) be, and they are hereby appointed appraisers, for the purpose

of valuing all sheep killed or injured by Dogs, whose owners intend applying to the Council for compensation under the provisions of the aforesaid act. for Polling Div No 1 Thos Lyon & Wm N. Ego.
for Polling Div No 2 Geo Burgess & Henry Rennie
for Polling Div No 3. John S Taylor & Sol Dodwick
for Polling Div No 4 John Prout & W. G. Reid

2nd

It shall be the duty of the aforesaid appraisers, on being notified to proceed to the place where sheep have been killed or injured by Dogs within his Division, and make and give to the owner thereof a valuation in writing and signed by him, which valuation shall be taken to the Council and used as evidence as to the amount of injury done.

3rd

The appraisers shall receive as pay for their services the sum of \$1 $\frac{50}{100}$, for each occasion on which they are called upon to make a valuation.

4th

Be it further enacted that no claim for damage, not valued by one of the aforesaid appraisers, or their successors in office shall be entertained by the Council, and any Person having sheep killed or injured by Dogs, who intend applying to the Council for compensation, shall within thirty-six hours have them valued by one of the aforesaid Valuers or their successors in office.

By-Law No 164

A By-Law to provide for borrowing money to build a bridge on the sideline near Pees Mill in Udora within the municipality of the Township of Georgina.

Whereas the bridge above referred to became dangerous to public traffic and has been removed,

And whereas it has been deemed advisable to replace said bridge by a substantial cement structure and for that purpose it will be necessary to raise the sum of \$3500.00

And whereas the total amount required to be raised annually for the payment of said debt and interest over and above all other rates and assessments amounts to \$475.53,

And whereas the amount of the whole rateable property of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina according to the last revised assessment Roll amounts to the sum of \$922676.00.

And whereas the amount of the existing Debenture Debt of the said Corporation is \$15400.00 made up as follows: ³⁷⁴⁵ Debenture S.S. No 2 \$3000- Debenture S.S. No 4, \$6402.17 Debenture S.S. No 9, and \$2300.63 Mossington bridge Debenture.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows

That it shall be lawful for the Reeve of the said Municipality and he is hereby authorized for the purpose aforesaid to borrow the sum of \$3500.00 and to issue Debenture

Under the seal of the said Corporation to the amount of \$3500.00 in sums of not less than \$100.00 each payable within a period of ten years with interest at six per cent per annum in equal annual instalments of principal and interest as set forth in the schedule here to,

2nd That said Debiture shall be sealed with the seal of the said Corporation and shall be signed by the Reeve and Treasurer thereof, and shall be known and marked Bridge Debiture.

3rd That the said Debiture shall be payable at the Standard Bank Pefferlaw on the days and times herein set out.

4th That for the payment of said Debitures from year to year as they mature there shall be raised and levied in each and every year during the said period of ten years, on all the rateable property of the said Municipality in addition to all other rates the sum of \$475.53 being a sum sufficient to pay the several instalments of principal and interest accruing due on said debt as provided in the following schedule.
