By-Law No 172

Whereas by Sub Sec 3 Section 84 Chap 229 R. S. O. Power is given to Municipal Councils to pass By-Laws to require that all on any shop where goods are exposed and offered for sale by retail, shall remain closed any day of the week between the hours of 7 o'clock P.M. and 5 o'clock A.M. of the following day.

And whereas a petition has been presented to the Council signed by a majority of the Merchant doing business in this Municipality praying that such a By-Law be passed.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York.

- 1st That all places of business except Barber shops and Barber and Parlors where goods are offered for sale by retail within the Township of Georgina - save and except that little hamlet known as Baldwin - shall close at the hour of 7 o'clock P.M. on Monday, Wednesday & Friday of each week throughout the year and shall remain closed until 5 o'clock A.M. of the following day.
- 2nd It shall not be unlawful to continue serving any customers that were within the place of business prior to the hour of closing.
- 3rd Any person found guilty of violating the provisions of this By-Law, shall upon conviction thereof be liable to a penalty of not less than Four Dollars or more than Twenty Five Dollars, together with costs.
- 4th That this By-Law shall take effect and come into force on the 10th day of June 1918.

By-Law No 173

Authorizing the Planting, Trimming and Cutting down of trees in the Highways.

Whereas it is deemed expedient for the purpose of public improvement and safety to have to authorize and empower a Committee of the Council to plant, trim and cut down the trees in its highways.

And whereas under the provisions of section 487 of The Municipal Act the Council has the right to pass such a By-law.

Therefore be it enacted by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina, that the Reeve and Road Commissioner holding office and appointment from time to time, shall be and they are hereby declared and appointed to be a Committee for the purpose following:

- (A) Plant or cause to be planted trees in the highways of the Municipality,
- (B) Lim or cause to be trimmed all trees on private property the branches of which extend over a highway,
- (C) Cut down or remove or cause to be cut down or removed all decayed trees,
- (D) Remove or transplant or cause to be removed or transplanted any tree planted or growing in any highway, square, lawn or other public communication after 48 hours notice in writing to the occupant of the land opposite to which the tree is planted or growing, but no live tree unless within 30 feet of another tree, shall be removed without the consent of such occupant.

2nd The notice mentioned in clause "D." may be given by leaving it with a grown up person resident upon the land, or if the land is unoccupied by posting it in a conspicuous place on the land.

3rd The express permission of the Council is hereby given the aforesaid Committee to exercise the powers conferred on them, as and when the Council or the said Committee deem necessary for the purpose of public improvement or safety of travel upon the highways of this municipality:
