A By-Law to appoint Auditors, Assessor, Collector, Sheep Valuator and Member of the Board of Health for the Township of Georgina for the year 1919.

The Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows:

- 1st: That Charles F. Anderson and William N. Ego be and are hereby appointed Auditors of Township accounts and that they be paid for the due performance of their duties the sum of \$8.00 each,
- 2nd: That Wilmet Riddell be and is hereby appointed Assessor for the Township of Georgina for the year 1919, and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties as such the sum of \$70.00,
- 3rd: That John Evans be and is hereby appointed Collector of Taxes for the Township of Georgina for the year 1919, and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties as such the sum of \$75.00,

- 5th: That Donald Ego and Richard Crossberry be and are hereby appointed members of the Board of Health.

By-law 183

A By-law to impose and add five per cent. to all taxes not paid by the 10th day of December of the year for which said taxes are due.

Whereas power is given to Municipal Councils to pass By-laws to impose additional percentage to all taxes not paid by a date to be mentioned in said By-law.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York

That an extra five per cent. be imposed and added to all taxes not paid into the hands of the Collector of taxes on or before the 10th day of December of the year for which said taxes are chargeable, and that notice of said additional percentage be printed or written on all tax bills or notices delivered or sent out by the Collector.

By-Law No 184

A By-Law to appoint an hour and place for holding nomination, also polling booths, Deputy Returning Officers and Poll clerks for the Municipal Election of January 5th 1920

The Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows,

- 1st That the Nomination Meeting for the year 1920 be held at the Peffulaw Hall on Monday December 29th 1919 between the hours of one and two o'clock in the afternoon
- 2nd That the polling booth for polling division No 1 be at the Methodist Hall Virginia and that Willard Arnold be Deputy Returning Officer, and that Frank Lyons be Poll clerk
- 3rd That the Polling booth for polling division No 2 be at the Hall Peffulaw, and that Thomas Shearer be Deputy Returning Officer and John Connor Poll clerk
- 4th That the Polling booth for Polling division No 3 be at the School House Udora, and that Joseph W. Westgath be Deputy Returning Officer and that William Harvey be Poll clerk
- 5th That the Polling booth for Polling division No 4 be at Stattons Hall Egypt and that John M. Riddell be Deputy Returning Officer and Sam Park Poll clerk
- 6 That in the event of an election being held that the said Deputy Returning Officers be paid for their services as such the sum of \$4.00 each, and Poll clerks \$3.00 each, Constables when employed \$3.00 each,
