- 1st: That Charles F. Anderson and William N. Ego be and are hereby appointed Auditors of township accounts and that they be paid for the due performance of their duties the sum of \$8.00 each,
  - 2nd: That Wilfred Riddell be and is hereby appointed Assessor for the Township of Georgina for the year 1919, and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties as such the sum of \$70.00,
  - 3rd: That John Evans be and is hereby appointed Collector of Taxes for the Township of Georgina for the year 1919, and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties as such the sum of \$75.00,
  - 4th: That the following named parties be appointed Sheep Valuator under By-Law No 162, Polling division No 1: Thos Lyon and Richard Nealon, Polling division No 2: George Burgess and Harry Remond Polling division No 3: John L. By-Law 183

A By-Law to impose and add five per cent. to all taxes not paid by the 10<sup>th</sup> day of December of the year for which said taxes are due.

Whereas power is given to Municipal Councils to pass By-Laws to impose additional percentage to all taxes not paid by a date to be mentioned in said By-Law,  
 Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York  
 That an extra five per cent. be imposed and added to all taxes not paid into the hands of the Collector of Taxes on or before the 10<sup>th</sup> day of December of the year for which said taxes are chargeable, and that notice of said additional percentage be printed or written on all Tax Bills or notices delivered or sent out by the Collector.

A By-Law to appoint an hour and place for holding Nomination, also Polling booths, Deputy Returning Officer and Poll clerks for the Municipal Election of January 5<sup>th</sup> 1920.

The Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows:

- 1<sup>st</sup> That the Nomination meeting for the year 1920 be held at the Pefferlaw Hall on Monday December 29<sup>th</sup> 1919 between the hours of one and two o'clock in the afternoon.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> That the polling booth for polling division no 1 be at the Methodist Hall Virginia and that Willard Arnold be Deputy Returning Officer, and that Frank Lyons be Poll Clerk.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> That the Polling booth for polling division no 2 be at the Hall Pefferlaw, and that Thomas Sharran be Deputy Returning Officer and John Conner Poll Clerk.
- 4<sup>th</sup> That the Polling booth for polling division no 3 be at the School house Edora, and that Joseph W. Westgaert be Deputy Returning Officer and that William Harry be Poll Clerk.
- 5<sup>th</sup> That the Polling booth for polling division no 4 be at Stations Hall Egypt, and that John M. Riddell be Deputy Returning Officer and Sam Park Poll Clerk.
- 6<sup>th</sup> That in the event of an election being held that the said Deputy Returning Officer be paid for their service as such the sum of \$4.00 each, and Poll Clerks \$3.00 each, Constables when employed \$3.00 each,
