By-law No 195

A By-law to regulate the running at large of Dogs.

Whereas under the provisions of the Municipal Act Councils of Cities Towns Villages & Townships are authorized to pass By-laws for regulating the running at large of dogs,

And whereas by the Dog Tax and Sheep Protection Act of 1920 it is provided that after the first day of April 1921 in Towns Villages and Townships every owner of a dog shall procure from the Corporation a tag for each dog owned by him and shall keep such tag securely affixed on the dog at all times.

- Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina
- 1st That the Assessor of the said Township be and is hereby required to comply with the provisions of the dog Tax and Sheep Protection Act in reference to the assessment of dogs, and to deliver to every person assessed a numbered tag for each dog bitch or spayed bitch by him owned, and shall keep a record of the number of the tag and to whom delivered, and shall return said record to the Clerk along with the Assessment Roll,
 - 2nd That the Clerk shall procure and deliver to the Assessor suitable dog tags, and shall keep a record of the number of the tag and to whom it has been issued, and after the Assessor has returned his Roll to supply tags to any owners of dogs requiring same and to charge a fee of 25 cents for each tag
 - 3rd The owner of any dog receiving a tag shall keep such tag securely fixed on the

dog at all times, and any dog which does not wear a tag, and which is found off the premises of the owner and not under the control of any person may be killed by any person,

4. Every owner of a dog who neglects to procure a tag and to keep the same affixed to his dog shall incur a penalty of not less than \$10. and not more than \$25. for each such offence, and every penalty when collected shall be paid over to the Treasurer of the Municipality

By-law No 196

A By-law to provide for expenditure on roads in the Township of Georgina during the year 1921.

Whereas the regulations of the Department of Public Highways of Ontario require that the expenditure on township roads under the Ontario Highways Act and amendments thereto, shall be provided for annually by Township By-law

Therefore the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Georgina enacts as follows,

- 1st The sum of \$1500. is hereby appropriated from monies raised by taxation ~~of~~ for expenditure upon construction on the roads in the said Township during the year 1921.
- 2nd The sum of \$3000- is hereby appropriated from monies raised by taxation for expenditure upon maintenance and repair on the roads in the said Township during the year 1921.
- 3rd The said monies shall be expended under the direction of the duly appointed Township Road Commissioner.
- 4th All work on which the said monies shall be expended shall be performed in accordance with the last revised regulation respecting Township roads issued by the Department of Public Highways of Ontario.
- 5th The Clerk shall transmit two certified copies of this By-law to the Deputy Minister Department of Public Highways of Ontario, within thirty days after the passing thereof.
