## By-Law No 231.

## By-Law No 232

A By-Law appointing a Road Superintendent for the Township of Georgina in the County of York.

Whereas it is desirable that the laying out and supervision of all work and expenditure upon improvement and maintenance of roads within the exclusive jurisdiction of this township, should be under the supervision of a road superintendent, acting under their direction of this Council.

And whereas it is the desire of this council to take advantage of The Ontario Highways Act, and to receive the Government grant as provided in sec 2 subsection I of the said act,

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the corporation of the said Township of Georgina.

1st That Claud Willis is appointed road superintendent in the said Township to act as aforesaid in accordance with the provisions of said section II, of the said act from the first day of April 1925. and during the pleasure of the said Council.

2nd, That the said Claud Willis shall be paid at the rate of \$ 4.00 per day for such time as he may be employed,

3rd That it shall be the duty of the superintendent to lay out and supervise all work and expenditure on roads within the exclusive jurisdiction of the Township Council, and to conform to such general regulations as the Department of Highways may prescribe.

4th That all by-laws or parts thereof, and all, or any, resolutions of said council contrary hereto or inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed .

5th That a certified copy of this by-law be forwarded by the Clerk without delay, to the deputy Minister of Public Highways, Toronto.

## By-Law No234.

A By-Law to provide for expenditure on roads in the Township of Georgina during the year 1925.

Whereas the regulations of the department of public Highways of Ontario require that the expenditure on township roads under the Ontario Highways Act and amendments thereto, shall be provided for annually by Township By-Law.

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina enacts as follows-

(1) The sum of \$ 2000. is hereby appropriated from monies raised by a special Rate for expenditure upon construction on the Roads in the said Township during the year 1925.

(2) The sum of \$ 3000. is hereby appropriated, from monies raised by a special rate, for expenditure upon maintenance and repair on the Roads in the Township during the year 1925.

(3) The said monies shall be expended under the direction of the duly appointed Road Superintendent.

(4) All work on which the said monies shall be expended shall be performed in accordance with the last revised regulations respecting township roads issued by the Department of Public Highways of Ontario.

(5) The clerk shall transmit two certified copies of this by-law to the Deputy Minister, Department of Public Highways of Ontario, within thirty days after the passing thereof.

## By-Law No. 235.

A By-Law to provide for the borrowing of Money by the issue and sale of Debentures for the purpose of constructing Bridges on the Highways within the Municipality of the Township of Georgina.

Whereas several Bridges on the Highways within the Municipality of the Township of Gergina have become out of repair and are dangerous to Public traffic, and whereas it is deemed advisable to replace said bridges by good and permanent structures, and for that purpose it will be necessary to raise the sum of seven thousand dollars (7000) and,

Whereas the total amount required to be raised annually for the payment of said debt and interest over and above all other rates and assessments amounts to nine hundred and six dollars and fifty-four cents (906.54) and-

Whereas the amount of the whole rateable property of the Township of Georgina according to the last revised assessment roll amounts to the sum of NINE HUNDRED ANDEIGHTY ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTY FIVE DOLLARS and-

Whereas the amount of the existing Debenture Debt of the said Corporation of the Township of Georgina is Two Thousand and Eighty-nine dollars and Forty-Five Cents in School section No 2. Two Thousand one Hundred and Thirty-Three Dollars and Sixty-One cents in School section No 4. and Five Thousand One Hundred and Sixty-nine Dollars and Forty cents in Schools Section No 9. and One Thousand Two Hundred and Seventy-Two Dollars and Twelve Cents for the Udora Bridge.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows-

(I) That it shall be lawful for the Reeve of the said Municipality, and He is hereby authorized for the purpose aforesaid to borrow the sum of Seven Thousand Dollars (\$ 7000). and to issue Debentures under the seal of the said Corporation to the amount of Seven Thousand Dollars, in sums of not less than One Hundred Dollars (100) each payable within a period of Ten Years, with interest at Five per cent, per annum in equal annual instalments of Principal and Interest, as set forth in the schedule hereto.

(by-law No 235 continued)

(2) That said Debentures shall be sealed with the Seal of the said Corporation, and shall be signed by the Reeve and Treasurer thereof, and shall be known and marked Bridge Debentures.

(3) That the said Debentures shall be payable at the Treasures Office on the days and time herein set out.

(4) That for the payment of said Debentures from year to year, as they Mature, there shall be raised and Levied in each and every year during the said period of Ten years on all the rateable property of the said Municipality in addition to all other rates, the sum of Nine Hundred and Six Dollars and Fifty-Four cents.
