By-Law No 243

A by-law to provide for expenditure on roads in the Township of Georgina during the Year 1926

Whereas the regulations of the Department of Public Highways of Ontario require that the expenditure on township roads under the Ontario Highways Act, and amendments thereto, shall be provided for annually by Township By-Law..

Therefore the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Georgina enacts as follows.

- (1) The sum of \$ 2000. is hereby appropriated from monies raised by special Tax for expenditure upon construction on the roads in the Township during the year 1926.
- (2) The sum of \$ 3000. is hereby appropriated, from monie caised by special Tax for expenditue upon maintenance, and repair on roads in the township during the year 1926.
- (3) The saidn monies shall be expended under the direction of the duly appointed Township Road Superintendent.
- (4) All work on which the said monies shall be expended shall be performed in accordance with the last regulatiobns respecting township roads issued by ybbe Department of Public Highways of Ontario.
- (5) The Clerk shall transmit two certified copies of this By-law to the Deputy Min ister Department of Public Highways of Ontario, within thirty days after the passing thereof

A. By-Law. to repeal By-Laws. no 1, 1894 and no 178, 1919. and appoint a Clerk, for the Township of Georgina

By-Law. No. 245

A By-Law. to authorize the Head & Treasurer of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina to borrow certain sums to meet the now current expenditures.

Whereas the taxes levied for the current expenditure of the said Corporation for the year have not yet been fully collected, there being uncollected of such taxes a sum not less than the sum hereby authorized to be borrowed.

And whereas the sum of Four Thousand Dollars is required to meet the now current expenses of the said Corporation, and it is expedient to authorize the Head and Treasurer to borrow the said sum.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina as follows:-

1st.

That the Head, with the Treasurer of the said Corporation, be and they are hereby authorized, under the seal of the Corporation to borrow from The Standard Bank of Canada the sum of Four Thousand Dollars required to meet the now current expenditure of said Corporation.

2nd

That the said Head with the Treasurer aforesaid, be, and they are hereby authorized to pay or allow the said Bank interest on the said sum so borrowed at the rate of six per cent. per annum.

3rd

That a promissory note or notes covenant or agreement, sealed with the corporate seal, and signed on behalf of the Corporation by the Reeve and Treasurer, be duly executed and given to the said Bank as aforesaid as security for the repayment of the amount borrowed, with interest thereon as aforesaid.

4th.

That the Standard Bank of Canada be and is hereby appointed Banker of the Corporation and is hereby authorized to pay and honor all Cheques and orders for the payment of money made, signed or drawn in the name of the said Corporation by Reeve and Treasurer and further, to accept for deposit to the credit of the Corporation all cheques, drafts, notes, bills and other negotiable instruments endorsed in the name of the said Corporation by Reeve and Treasurer.
