

## By-Law. no. 262.

A By-Law to appoint Auditors, Assessor, Collector of taxes, members of Board of Health, and sheep Valuators for the Township of Georgina for the year 1928.

The Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows.

1 That Donald McDonald and J. W. Brignall be and are hereby appointed Auditors of the Township accounts and that they be paid for the due performance of their duties the sum of \$8.00 each.

2 That J. R. Humphrey be and is hereby appointed Assessor of the Township of Georgina for the year 1928 and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties the sum of \$25.00

3 That John Evans be and is hereby appointed Collector of Taxes for the Township of Georgina for the year 1928 and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties the sum of \$80.00

4 That the Reeve, Clerk, Wm. M. Harvey and the Medical Health Officer be and are hereby appointed a board of health for the Township of Georgina for the year 1928.

5 That the following persons be and are hereby appointed Sheep Valuators in their respective polling Divisions, and that they be paid for each valuation the sum of \$1.50

## By-Law. 263.

A. By-Law to provide for expenditures on roads in the Township of Georgina during the year 1928.

Whereas the regulations of the Department of Public Highways of Ontario require that the expenditure on Township roads under the Highway Improvement Act, and amendments thereto, shall be provided for annually by Township By-Law.

Therefore the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Georgina enacts as follows.

(1) The sum of \$6000.00 is hereby appropriated from monies raised by special tax for expenditure upon construction and maintenance on the roads in the said Township during the year 1928 as follows.

Road Construction	\$1000.00
Bridge Construction	1500.00
Machinery	200.00
Superintendence	400.00
Maintenance and repair.	2900.00
Total estimated expenditure	6000.00

(2) The said monies shall be expended under the direction of the duly appointed Township Road Superintendent.

(3) All work on which the said monies shall be expended shall be performed in accordance with the last revised regulations respecting Township roads issued by the Department of Public Highways of Ontario.

(4) The Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of this By-Law to the Deputy Minister, Department of Public Highways of Ontario, within thirty days after the passing thereof.

## By-Law no 268.

A. By-Law to authorize the Head and Treasurer of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina to borrow certain sums to meet the now current expenditure.

Whereas the taxes levied for the current expenditure of the said Corporation for the year have not yet been fully collected, there being uncollected of such taxes a sum not less than the sum hereby authorized to be borrowed.

And whereas the sum of Four thousand Dollars is required to meet the now current expenses of the said Corporation, and it is expedient to authorize the Head and Treasurer to borrow the said sum.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina as follows.

1. That the Head, with the Treasurer of the said Corporation be, and they are hereby authorized, under the seal of the Corporation to borrow from the Standard Bank of Canada the sum of Four thousand Dollars required to meet the now current expenditure of said Corporation.

2. That the said Head with the Treasurer aforesaid, be, and they are hereby authorized to pay or allow the said Bank interest on the said sum so borrowed at the rate of six per cent. per annum.

3<sup>rd</sup>. That a promissory note or notes covenant or agreement, sealed with the Corporate seal, and signed on behalf of the Corporation by the Reeve and Treasurer, be duly executed and given to the said bank as aforesaid as security for the payment of the amount borrowed, with interest thereon as aforesaid.

4<sup>th</sup>. That the Standard Bank of Canada be and is hereby appointed Banker of the Corporation and is hereby authorized to pay and honor all cheques and orders for the payment of money made, signed or drawn in the name of the said Corporation by the Treasurer and further, to accept for deposit to the credit of the Corporation all cheques, drafts, notes, bills and other negotiable instruments endorsed in the name of the said Corporation by the Treasurer.
