A. By-Law to appoint Auditors, Assessor, Collector of Taxes, members of Board of Health, and Sheep Valuator for the Township of Georgina for the year 1929.

## By-Law no. 276.

A. By-Law To provide for expenditures on roads in the Township of Georgina during the year 1929

Whereas the regulations of the Department of Public Highways of Ontario require that the expenditure on Township roads under the Highway Improvement Act and amendments thereto, shall be provided for annually by Township By-Law.

Therefore the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Georgina enacts as follows.

- (1) The sum of 6000.00 is hereby appropriated from monies raised by special tax for expenditure upon construction and maintenance on the roads in the said Township during the year 1929 as follows.

Road Construction	\$ 1000.00
Bridge Construction	\$ 1500.00
Machinery	\$ 200.00
Superintendence	\$ 400.00
Maintenance & Repair.	\$ 2900.00
Total estimated expenditure	\$ 6000.00.

2. The said monies shall be expended under the direction of the duly appointed Township Road Superintendent

3. All work on which the said monies shall be expended shall be performed in accordance with the last revised regulations respecting township roads issued by the Department of Public Highways of Ontario.

4. The Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of this By-Law to the Deputy Minister, Department of Public Highways of Ontario, within thirty days after the passing thereof.

## By-Law no 277.

A. By-Law to appoint a Community Hall Board in conformity with sec. 8. of the Community Halls Act. 1920 and the regulations thereunder.

Whereas a Community Hall has been established at Pefferlaw in the Municipal Corporation of The Township of Georgina in the County of York.

And whereas it is necessary under sec 8 of the Act, to appoint a Board of Management for the said Community Hall.

Therefore the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Georgina enacts as follows.

- 1 That the following be and are hereby appointed a Board of Management for the Community Hall at Pefferlaw, namely Wilmot Riddell and Noblely Matt representing the Council, for the ensuing year, and J. S. Moore, W. H. Harrison, R. H. Corner, Albert Gibson and David Mc Mullen for the ensuing two years.
- 2 That the Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of this By-Law to the Minister of Agriculture for the Province of Ontario.
- 3 That all By-Laws or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this By-Law be and the same are hereby repealed.

By-Law no. 278.

A. By-Law To authorize the Head and Treasurer of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina to borrow certain sums to meet the current ordinary expenditure of the Corporation, and the sums required to be raised in the current year for High and Public School purposes.

Whereas the Council of the said Municipality deems the sum of Four Thousand Dollars necessary to meet the current ordinary expenditure of the Corporation and the sums required to be raised in the current year for High and Public School purposes until the taxes are collected, and it is expedient, subject to the conditions hereinafter contained, to authorize the Head and Treasurer to borrow the said sum.

And whereas the ordinary expenditure of the said Municipality for the next preceding year amounted to Six Thousand Five Hundred Dollars.

And whereas the amount heretofore borrowed and outstanding for the purposes aforesaid and the amount hereby authorized to be borrowed do not exceed 90 per cent. of the ordinary expenditure of the said Municipality for the next preceding year, together with the amount required to be raised for High and Public School purposes for the current year.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Georgina as follows. -

1<sup>st</sup>. That the Head and Treasurer of the said Corporation be and they are hereby authorized, in the manner and subject to the conditions herein mentioned, to borrow from the Canadian Bank of Commerce the sum of Four Thousand Dollars required to meet the current ordinary expenditure of the Corporation, and the sums required to be raised for High and public school purposes for the current year, until the taxes are collected.

2<sup>nd</sup>. That a promissory note or notes, sealed with the Corporate seal and signed on behalf of the Corporation by the Head and Treasurer thereof, for the amount of the said said loan and interest thereon at the rate of 6 per cent. per annum; and repayable on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of December 1929, be duly executed and given to the said bank as security for the repayment of the amount borrowed with interest thereon as aforesaid.

3 That the Polling Booth for Div. no. 2 be at the Community Hall, Pefferlaw, and that T. J. Shearer be Deputy Returning Officer, and that R. A. Snaddon be Poll Clerk.

4 That the Polling Booth for Div. no. 3 be at the School House, Udora, and that Joseph Westgarth be Deputy Returning Officer and J. E. Taylor be Poll Clerk.
