By-Law no. 296.

A. By-Law to provide for expenditure on roads in the Township of Georgina during the year 1931
 Whereas the regulations of the Department of Public Highways of Ontario require that the expenditures on Township Roads under the Highway Improvement Act, and amendments thereto, shall be provided for annually by Township By-Law.

Therefore the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Georgina enacts as follows.

I The sum of \$7500.⁰⁰ is hereby appropriated from monies raised by special tax for expenditure upon construction and maintenance on the roads in the said Township during the year 1931 as follows.

Road Construction	1500
Budget Construction	2500.
Machinery	200.
Superintendence	400.
Maintenance & Repair	2900.

Total estimated expenditure \$7500

2 The said monies shall be expended under the direction of the duly appointed Road Superintendent.
 3 All work on which the said monies shall be expended shall be performed in accordance with the last revised regulations respecting Township Roads issued by the Department of Public Highways of Ontario.
 4 The Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of this By-Law to the Deputy Minister, Department of Public Highways of Ontario, within thirty days after the passing thereof.

By-Law no 297.

A By-Law to authorize the Head and Treasurer of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina to borrow certain sums to meet the current ordinary expenditure of the Corporation, and the sums required to be raised in the current year for High and Public School purposes.

Whereas the Council of the said Municipality deems the sum of six Thousand Dollars necessary to meet the current ordinary expenditure of the Corporation and the sums required to be raised in the current year for High and Public School purposes until the taxes are collected, and it is expedient, subject to the conditions hereinafter contained, to authorize the Head and Treasurer to borrow the said sum.

And whereas the ordinary expenditure of the said Municipality for the next preceding year amounted to Six Thousand Five Hundred and sixty-Five Dollars

And whereas the amount heretofore borrowed and outstanding for the purposes aforesaid and the amount hereby authorized to be borrowed do not exceed 90 per cent. of the ordinary expenditure of the said Municipality for the next preceding year together with the amount required to be raised for High and Public School purposes for the current year.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Georgina as follows:-

1st That the Head and Treasurer of the said Corporation be and they are hereby authorized, in the manner and subject to the conditions herein mentioned, to borrow from the Canadian Bank of Commerce the sum of six Thousand Dollars required to meet the current ordinary expenditures of the Corporation, and the sums required to be raised for High and Public School purposes for the current year, until the taxes are collected.

2nd That a promissory note or notes, sealed with the Corporate seal and signed on behalf of the Corporation by the Head and Treasurer thereof, for the amount of the said loan and interest thereon at the rate of six per cent. per annum, and repayable on the 15th day of December 1931 be duly executed and given to the said bank as security for the repayment of the amount borrowed with interest thereon as aforesaid.
