A By-Law to appoint Auditors, Assessor, Collector of Taxes, members of the Board of Health, and Sheep Valuators for the Township of Georgina for the year 1932.

By-Law no 305

A By-Law to provide for expenditure on roads in the Township of Georgina during the year 1932.

Whereas the regulations of the Department of Highways of Ontario require that the expenditure on Township roads under the Highway Improvement Act, and amendments thereto, shall be provided for annually by Township By-Law.

Therefore the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Georgina enacts as follows:-

- (1) The sum of \$7300.00 is hereby appropriated from monies raised by special tax for expenditure upon construction and maintenance on the roads in the said Township during the year 1932 as follows:-

Road Construction	\$ 1000.00
Bridge Construction	\$ 2000.00
Machinery	\$ 1000.00
Superintendence	\$ 300.00
Maintenance & Repair	\$ 3000.00

Total estimated expenditure \$ 7300.00

- (2) The said monies shall be expended under the direction of the duly appointed Township Road Superintendent.

- (3) All work on which the said monies shall be expended shall be performed in accordance with the last revised regulations respecting Township roads issued by the Department of Highways of Ontario.

- (4) The Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of this By-Law to the Deputy Minister, Department of Highways, within thirty days after the passing thereof.

By-Law no 307.

To authorize the borrowing of money to meet current expenditures for the year 1932.

Whereas it is deemed necessary by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina to borrow an amount not at any time to exceed the sum of three thousand dollars, to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Corporation for the year, including the amounts for sinking fund, principal and interest falling due within the year upon the debts of the Corporation, school purposes, special rates purposes and for meeting the requirements of any board, commission or body and other purposes, for which the Corporation is required by law to provide.

And whereas the amount heretofore borrowed by the Corporation and outstanding (if any) for the purposes aforesaid and the amount hereby authorized to be borrowed under section 334 of the Municipal Act, Chapter 233 revised Statutes of Ont. 1927 as amended by the Municipal Amendment Act. 1932.

Be it Therefore Enacted as a By-Law by the said Council as follows.

I That the Head and Treasurer of the said Corporation be and they are hereby authorized to borrow from the Bank of Nova Scotia an amount not at any time to exceed the sum of three thousand dollars until such time as the taxes levied or to be levied shall be collected and applied to repay such advance.

2 That the said sum may be borrowed in one amount or in such sums, from time to time as may be found expedient and at such rate of interest as may be agreed on between the Head and Treasurer and the said Bank. 6 per cent per annum.

3 That as security for the sum or sums borrowed from time to time under this By-Law the Head and Treasurer are hereby authorized to give to the said Bank the promissory notes, and/or other forms of agreement of the Corporation signed by the Head and Treasurer and sealed with the seal of the Corporation as may be required by the said Bank.

4 That all the revenues of the said Corporation of whatsoever nature and kind be and the same are hereby charged to and in favour of the said Bank for and with the payment of any sum borrowed under this By-Law and the interest thereon as hereinbefore provided.

5 That the Head and Treasurer be and they are hereby, authorized to enter into an agreement or agreements with the

said bank sealed with the corporate seal and signed on behalf of the said corporation by the Head and Treasurer providing for the borrowing of the sum hereby authorized and the repayment thereof on or before the last business day of the current year and containing such other terms relating to such borrowing, repayment and the charge hereby created as may be required by the said Bank.

By-Law no 308.

A By-Law to authorize the Head and Treasurer of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina to borrow certain sums to meet the current ordinary expenditure of the Corporation, and the sums required to be raised in the current year for High School and Public School purposes.

Whereas the Council of the said Municipality deems the sum of three thousand dollars necessary to meet the current ordinary expenditure of the Corporation and the sums required to be raised in the current year for High School and Public School purposes until the taxes are collected, and it is expedient, subject to the conditions hereinafter contained, to authorize the Head and Treasurer to borrow the said sum.

And whereas the ordinary expenditure of the said Municipality for the next preceding year amounted to seven thousand dollars.

And whereas the amount (if any) heretofore borrowed, and outstanding for the purpose aforesaid and the amount hereby authorized to be borrowed do not exceed 50 per cent of the ordinary expenditure of the said Municipality for the next preceding year together with the amount required to be raised to be raised for High School and Public School purposes for the current year.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Georgina as follows.

That the Head and Treasurer of the said Corporation be and they are hereby authorized, in the manner and subject to the conditions herein mentioned, to borrow from the Canadian Bank of Commerce the sum of three thousand Dollars required to meet the current ordinary expenditure of the Corporation, and the sums required to be raised

for High School and Public School purposes for the current year, until the taxes are collected.

2nd. That a promissory note or notes, sealed with the Corporate seal and signed on behalf of the Corporation by the Head and Treasurer thereof, for the year amount of the said loan and interest thereon at the rate of 6 per cent. per annum and repayable on the 15th day of December 1932 be duly executed and given to the said Bank as security for the repayment of the amount borrowed with interest thereon as aforesaid.

A By-Law to appoint an hour and place for holding nomination meeting, also Polling Booths, Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks for the Municipal Election to be held on Monday the 2nd day of January 1933.

- 2 That the Polling Booth for Division no 1 be at the School House, Virginia, and that Willard Arnold be Deputy Returning Officer and that Frank Lyons be Poll Clerk.
- 3 That the Polling Booth for Division no 2 be at the Community Hall, Pefferlaw and that T. J. Shearer be Deputy Returning Officer and that R. D. Snoddon be Poll Clerk.
- 4 That the Polling Booth for Division no 3 be at the School House, Uxora, and that J. E. Taylor be Deputy Returning Officer and that Elm. M. Harvey be Poll Clerk.
- 5 That the Polling Booth for Division no 4 be at the United Church Hall, Egypt, and that Wilfred Riddell be Deputy Returning Officer and that Stuart Taylor be Poll Clerk.
- 6 That in event of an election being held the said Deputy Returning Officers shall be paid \$4.00 each, Poll Clerks \$3.00 each, and constables when employed \$1.50 each for the due performance of their duties, and that \$2.00 be allowed for each Polling Booth.
- 7 That all By-Laws, or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this By-Law be and the same are hereby repealed, and the seal of the Corporation be hereto attached.
