A. By-Law to appoint Auditor's, Assessor, Collector of Taxes, members of the Board of Health and Sheep Valuators for the Township of Georgina for the year 1933.

The Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows.

1 That J. E. Porter and Charles Anderson be and are hereby appointed Auditors of the Township accounts and that they be paid for the due performance of their duties the sum of \$10.00 each.

2 That J. H. Humphrey be and is hereby appointed assessor for the Township of Georgina for the year 1933, and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties the sum of \$125.00.

3 That George Burgess be and is hereby appointed collector of Taxes for the Township of Georgina for the year 1933, and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties the sum of \$75.00.

4 That the Reeve, Clerk, and Wm. M. Harvey and the Medical Health Officer be and are hereby appointed a Board of Health for the Township of Georgina for the year 1933.

By-Law no 315

A. By-Law to provide for expenditure on roads in the Township of Georgina during the year 1933.

Whereas the regulations of the Department of Highways of Ontario require that the expenditure on Township roads under the Highway Improvement Act, and amendments thereto, shall be provided for annually by Township By-Law

Therefore the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Georgina enacts as follows.

I The sum of \$6500.00 is hereby appropriated from monies raised by special tax for expenditure upon construction and maintenance on the roads in the said Township during the year 1933 as follows:

Road Construction	\$ 1000.00
Bridge Construction	\$ 1200.00
Machinery	\$ 1000.00
Superintendence	\$ 300.00
Maintenance + Repair	\$ 3000.00
Total estimated expenditure	\$ 6500.00

2 The said monies shall be expended under the direction of the duly appointed Township Road Superintendent.

3 All work on which the said monies shall be expended shall be performed in accordance with the last revised regulations respecting Township Roads issued by the Department of Highways of Ontario.

4 The Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of this By-Law to the Deputy Minister, Department of Highways, within thirty days after the passing thereof.

By-Law no 316.

A By-Law to give force and effect to an award made by a Board of Arbitration on the 11th day of March 1933 for the purpose of forming a Union School Section out of a portion of Georgina Township and a portion of the Township of Scott.

Whereas a petition of certain ratepayers of School Section no 6 of the Township of Georgina, the Municipal Council of the said Township did appoint an Arbitrator to meet with a like Arbitrator appointed by the Municipal Council of the Township of Scott and the Public School Inspector of this jurisdiction to consider the proposal of said petitioners to form a Union School Section out of parts of the said Townships aforesaid.

And whereas the said Board of Arbitration consisting of J. R. Ferguson, Public School Inspector, J. H. Dempsey representing Georgina Township and Edwin Stwier representing Scott Township did meet on Saturday the 25th day of February 1933 and after careful consideration did award that certain properties in the Township of Georgina known as School Section no 6 be united with certain properties being part of School Section no 5 in the Township of Scott to form a Union School Section.

Whereas it is necessary and desirable to give force and effect to the said Arbitrators award, and in compliance with the Statutes made and provided in such cases, that the conditions of the said Arbitrators award be embodied in a By-Law to be passed by the Councils of the Municipalities interested therein.

(1) Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same that the now existing School Section no 6 of the Township of Georgina and joined with certain properties of School Section no 5 of the Township of Scott, being East Half of lots 34 and 35 in the second Concession, the whole of lot 35 and the West half of lot 34 in the third Concession, to be known as Union School Section no 6-6 in the Townships of Georgina and Scott as set out in the Arbitrators award made out and promulgated the 11th day of March 1933.

- (2) And it appearing that the assessed value of the lands so set apart to form the aforesaid Union School Section no 6-6 of the Townships of Georgina and Scott. as follows. -

Lands in Georgina Township	\$ 78650.00
Lands in Scott. Township	9100.00
Making a Total amount of.	\$ 87750.00

it is further hereby enacted that the portion which each part of the section in each Municipality will be liable to contribute toward the maintenance and support of the said Union School Section, and the necessary expenses therewith shall be the fraction of the sum or sums required which the assessed value above set out of each of the said portions of land in each Township bears to the total assessed value of the section. subject to any change which may occur therein from time to time as assessments may be altered.

- (3) That this By-Law shall be in full force and effect at and from the 25th day of December, 1933 as by Statutes relating therein provided.

- (4) That all By-Laws inconsistent with the provisions of this By-Law be and the same are hereby repealed.

By-Law no 317

A. By-Law To authorize the Head and Treasurer of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina to borrow certain sums to meet the current expenditures of the Corporation.

Whereas the Council of the said Municipality deems the sum of Three Thousand Dollars necessary to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Corporation for the present year, and it is expedient, subject to the conditions hereinafter contained, to authorize the Head and Treasurer to borrow the said sum.

And Whereas the revenues of the Corporation for the next preceding year exclusive of moneys borrowed and of proceeds derived from the sale of debentures in that year, were as follows:-

Be it therefore enacted by the Corporation of the Township of Georgina as follows:-

1st. That the Head and Treasurer of the said Corporation be and they are hereby authorized, in the manner and subject to the conditions herein mentioned to borrow from the Canadian Bank of Commerce the sum of Three Thousand Dollars required to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Corporation for the year.

2nd. That all revenues of the Corporation are hereby charged with the repayment of any sum, and interest thereon, borrowed pursuant to this By-law, and with the repayment of all other sums (and interest thereon) which have been or which may be borrowed in the current year to meet current expenditures of the Corporation for the said year.

3rd. That a promissory note or notes sealed with the Corporate seal and signed on behalf of the Corporation by the Head and Treasurer thereof for the amount (and interest thereon) that may be borrowed pursuant to the authority of this By-law be given to the said Bank as security for the repayment of the amount borrowed with interest thereon.

4th. That an agreement sealed with the Corporate seal and signed on behalf of the Corporation by the Head and Treasurer thereof be given to the said Bank as security, providing for:-

- (a) The borrowing of the said sum.

- (b) The charging of all revenues of the Corporation with repayment as provided for in this By-Law.
- (c) The making and delivering to the Bank of a promissory note or notes as provided for in this By-Law; and
- (d) The payment (while any moneys borrowed to meet current expenditures for the said year remain unpaid) to the said Bank of all amounts from time to time received by the Corporation on account of revenues.

By-Law no 318

To authorize the borrowing of money to meet current expenditures for the year.

Whereas it is deemed necessary by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina to borrow an amount not to exceed at any time the sum of Three Thousand Dollars to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Corporation for the year, including the amounts for sinking fund, principal and interest falling due within the year upon the debts of the Corporation, school purposes, special rates purposing and for meeting the requirements of any Board Commission or body and other purposes for which the Corporation is required by law to provide.

And whereas the amount heretofore borrowed by the Corporation and outstanding (if any) for the purposes aforesaid and the amount hereby authorized to be borrowed do not exceed the amount which may be lawfully borrowed under section 334 of the Municipal Act, Chapter 233, Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1927 as amended by the Municipal Amendment Act, 1932 (22 George V. Chapter 29, section 12.)

Be it Therefore enacted as a By-Law by the said Council as follows:

- (1) That the Head and Treasurer of the said Corporation be and they are hereby authorized to borrow from The Bank of Nova Scotia an amount not at any time to exceed the sum of Three Thousand Dollars until such time as the taxes levied or to be levied shall be collected and applied to repay such advance.
- (2) That the said amount may be borrowed in one amount or in such sums from time to time as may be found expedient and at such rate of interest as may be agreed on between the Head and Treasurer and The said Bank.
- (3) That as security for the sum or sums borrowed from time to time under this By-Law the Head and Treasurer are hereby authorized to give to the said Bank the Promissory notes, and/or other forms of agreement of the Corporation signed by the Head and Treasurer and sealed with the seal of the Corporation as may be required by the said Bank.
- (4) That the Head and Treasurer be and they are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement or agreements with the said Bank sealed with the corporate seal and signed on behalf of the said Corporation by the Head and

Treasurer providing for the borrowing of the sum hereby authorized and the repayment thereof on or before the last business day of the current year and containing such other terms relating to such borrowing, repayment and the charge hereby created as may be required by the said Bank.

By-Law no 319

A By-Law to provide for a penalty to be added for the non-payment of taxes in the Township of Georgina. Whereas power is given Municipal Councils to pass a By-Law to impose additional percentage to all taxes not paid by a date to be mentioned in said By-Law.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows:-

- (1) That a penalty of one per cent be added on all taxes paid after December tenth and before January first, and thereafter at the rate of one per cent per month, of the year for which said taxes are chargeable, until the Collector has returned the Roll to the Treasurer.
- (2) That notices of said additional percentage be printed or written on all tax bills or notices delivered or sent out by the Collector.
- (3) That all By-Laws or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this By-Law be and the same are hereby repealed.

4 That the Polling Booth for Division no 3 be at the School House, Adora, and that J. E. Taylor be Deputy Returning Officer, and that Wm. M. Harvey be Poll Clerk.
