## By-Law no 326.

A By-Law to provide for expenditures on Roads in the Township of Georgina during the year 1934.

Whereas the regulations of the Department of Public Highways of Ontario require that the expenditures on Township Roads under the Highway Improvement Act, and amendments thereto, shall be provided for annually by Township By-Law.

Therefore the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Georgina enacts as follows.

I The sum of \$7500.00 is hereby appropriated from monies raised by Special Tax for expenditures upon construction and maintenance on the Roads in the said Township during the year 1934 as follows.

Road Construction	\$ 1000.00
Budge Construction	\$ 2000.00
Machinery	\$ 1000.00
Superintendence	\$ 300.00
Maintenance and Repair	\$ 3200.00
Total estimated expenditure	\$ 7500.00

2 The said monies shall be expended under the direction of the duly appointed Road Superintendent.

3 all work on which the said monies shall be expended shall be performed in accordance with the last revised regulations respecting Township Roads issued by the Department of Public Highways of Ontario

4 The Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of this By-Law to the Deputy Minister, Department of Public Highways of Ontario, within Thirty days after the passing thereof.

## By-Law no 327

Of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina

A. By-Law providing for a reduction of the term of subsisting contracts for the supply of Electric service in the Rural Power District or Districts of which the Township or any portion thereof forms a part, from twenty years to Five years in certain cases.

Whereas in pursuance of the Power Commission Act, and of By-Law no 222, the Municipal Corporation agreed with the Hydro-Electric Power Commission of Ontario herein-after referred to as the Commission, under date of the 29<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1924, for the supply of Electric power or energy to the Corporation, and to customers within the Township as therein provided;

And Whereas, in pursuance of such agreement, the Municipal Corporation has procured contracts in the standard form for electrical service in rural power districts which are effective for a period of twenty years from the date on which the Corporation was ready to serve such customers;

And Whereas it seems desirable to reduce the said period of twenty years in certain cases to a period of five years;

And Whereas the Commission has given its approval to such reduction in such cases under date of April 13, 1934;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina enacts as follows.

I Except as hereinafter provided, and notwithstanding anything contained in any such contract, any customer under contract with the Corporation for the supply of electric power or energy in any Rural Power District of which the Corporation or any portion thereof forms a part, may, after the expiration of five years from the date on which the customer commenced to take and use electric energy thereunder, give notice in writing of his desire to be relieved of the said contract, and thereupon such contract shall terminate after the expiration of one year from the date of such notice.

II Except where notice is given as provided by Clause I hereof, all such contracts shall remain in force in accordance with their original terms.

This By-Law shall not apply -

- (a) until after the repayment in full of any loan obtained by the customer under the Rural Power District Loans Act, being 20 George V, cap. 14;
- (b) to 'guarantee' contracts, which were entered into by the customer for the purpose of making guarantees to make possible the building or extension of any transmission line in any Rural Power District;
- (c) where the customer has taken electric power or energy thereunder for less than five years;
- (d) where the customer desiring to be relieved is in default for any sum or sums payable under his contract, whether the same became due prior to or subsequent to the giving of the notice provided for in Clause 1.

The Commission as trustee for the Municipal Corporation is hereby authorized and empowered to do all such acts, matters and things on behalf of the Corporation which may be necessary to give effect to the provisions and intent of this By-Law, and the doing of any such acts, matters and things shall not be deemed in any way a breach by the Commission of the provisions of the hereinbefore recited agreement between the Corporation and the Commission, dated the 29<sup>th</sup> day of April 1924

This By-Law shall come into force in any Rural Power District of which the Corporation or any portion thereof forms a part, only upon the passing of similar By-Laws by all of the Municipal Corporations which in whole or in part comprise the particular Rural Power District.

## By-Law no. 327 A

A By-Law to authorize the borrowing of \$ 3000.00

Whereas the Council of the Township of Georgina (hereinafter called the Municipality) deems it necessary to borrow the sum of \$ 3000.00 to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Municipality for the year;

And Whereas the total amount of the estimated revenues of the Municipality as set forth in the estimates adopted for the year 1934, not including revenues derivable or derived from arrears of taxes, borrowing and issues of Debentures is \$ 28749.63.

Therefore the Council of the Township of Georgina hereby enacts as follows.

1 The Head and the Treasurer are hereby authorized on behalf of the Municipality to borrow from time to time by way of promissory note from the Canadian Bank of Commerce a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate \$ 3000.00 to meet until the taxes are collected the current expenditures of the Municipality for the year, including the amounts required for the purposes mentioned in subsection (U) of the said section 334, and to give on behalf of the Municipality to the Bank a promissory note or notes sealed with the corporate seal and signed by the Head and Treasurer for the moneys so borrowed, with interest, which may be paid in advance or otherwise, at a rate not exceeding  $5\frac{1}{2}$  per centum per annum.

2 All sums borrowed pursuant to the authority of this by-law as well as all other sums borrowed in this year and in previous years from the said Bank for any or all of the purposes mentioned in the said section 334, shall, with interest thereon, be a charge upon the whole of the revenues of the Municipality for the current year and for all preceding years as and when such revenues are received.

3 The Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to apply in payment of all sums borrowed as aforesaid, together with interest thereon, all of the moneys hereafter collected or received either on account or realized in respect of taxes levied for the current year and preceding years or from any other source which may lawfully be applied for such purposes.

## By-Law no. 328

To authorize the borrowing of money to meet current expenditures for the year.

Whereas it is deemed necessary by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina to borrow an amount not at any time to exceed the sum of three Thousand Dollars to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Corporation for the year, including the amounts for sinking funds, principal and interest falling due within the year upon the debts of the Corporation, school purposes, special rates purposes and for meeting the requirements of any Board, Commission or body and other purposes for which the Corporation is required by law to provide

And whereas the amount heretofore borrowed by the Corporation and outstanding (if any) for the purposes aforesaid and the amount hereby authorized to be borrowed do not exceed the amount which may be lawfully borrowed under section 334 of the Municipal Act, Chapter 233, Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1927 as amended by the Municipal Amendment Act 1933.

Be it Therefore enacted as a By-Law by the said Council as follows.

- I That the Head and Treasurer of the said Corporation be and they are hereby authorized to borrow from the Bank of Nova Scotia an amount not at any time to exceed the sum of Three Thousand Dollars until such time as the taxes levied or to be levied shall be collected and applied to repay such advance.
- 2 That the said sum may be borrowed in one amount or in such sums from time to time as may be found expedient and at such rate of interest as may be agreed on between the Head and Treasurer and the said Bank.
- 3 That as security for the sum or sums borrowed from time to time under this By-Law the Head and Treasurer are hereby authorized to give to the said Bank the promissory notes, and, or other forms of agreement of the Corporation signed by the Head and Treasurer and sealed with the seal of the Corporation as may be required by the said Bank.
- 4 That the Head and Treasurer by and they are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement or agreements with the said Bank sealed with the corporate seal and signed on behalf of the said Corporation by the Head and



Treasurer providing for the borrowing of the sum hereby authorized and the repayment thereof on or before the last business day of the current year and containing such other terms relating to such borrowing, repayment and the charge hereby created as may be required by the said Bank.

## By-Law no 330

A. By-Law To close a part of Brock Street shown on Registered Plan no. 237, being part of lot 23 Concession 5, of the Township of Georgina in the County of York.

Whereas it is deemed necessary to close a portion of Brock Street and deed it back to the W.H. Johnston Estate, so that the lots shown on the Plan will be fronting on the road as now laid out.

Therefore the Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows:-

That the portion of Brock Street shown on the attached plan marked in red and described as follows, be closed and deeded to the W.H. Johnston Estate:-

All and singular that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate lying and being in the Township of Georgina, in the County of York, being composed of part of lot 23 in the fifth Concession of the said Township, being shown upon Registered Plan no 237 (recorded in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of North York) as part of Brock St. which parcel of land may be more particularly described as follows:-

Commencing at a point in the said lot no 23 defined as follows:-

Beginning at the North east angle of the said lot 23 thence southerly along the easterly limit of the said lot 23 a distance of 3517 feet to an iron pipe, thence South 81° 35' west a distance of 66' 9" to an iron pipe planted at the above mentioned point of commencement. Thence from the said point, south 81. 35' west a distance of 242' 1" more or less to a point in the line of the production southerly of the west limit of lot 29 as shown upon the said registered plan 237. Thence northerly along the line of the production of the west limit of lot 29 as aforesaid a distance of 15 feet more or less to the south westerly angle of the said lot 29. Thence south easterly along the southerly limit of the said lot 29 and lot 28 as shown upon the said Registered Plan 237 a distance of 356' 4" more or less to the south easterly angle of the said lot.

- 4 That the Polling Booth for Division no. 3 be at the School House, Udora and that J. E. Taylor be Deputy Returning Officer and that Wm. H. Harvey be Poll Clerk.
- 5 That the Polling Booth for Division no. 4 be at the United Church Hall, Egypt, and that Wilfrid Piddell be Deputy Returning Officer and that Stuart Taylor be Poll Clerk.
- 6 That in event of an Election being held the said Deputy Returning Officer shall be paid \$4.00 each, Poll Clerks \$3.00 each, and Constables when employed \$1.50 each for the due performance of their duties, and that \$2.00 be allowed for each Polling Booth.
- 7 That all By-Laws or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this By-Law be and the same are hereby repealed, and the seal of the Corporation be hereto attached.
