A BY-LAW to appoint Auditors, Assessor, Collectors of taxes, Members of Board of Health and Sheep Valuers for the Township of Georgina for the year 1936.

1. The MUNICIPAL COUNCIL of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows:-

1. That *J. E. Porter*.... and *C. F. Anderson*... be and are hereby appointed Auditors of the Township accounts and that they be paid for the due performance of their duties the sum of \$ *10.00*.... each.

2. That *J. H. Humphrey*.. be and is hereby appointed Assessor for the Township of Georgina for the year 1936, and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties the sum of \$ *125.00*....

A by-law to provide for the total expenditure on roads in the township of

Georgina

during the year 1936.

WHEREAS The Highway Improvement Act, Chapter 54, R.S.O., 1927 and amendments requires that the total expenditure on township roads and bridges be provided for annually by township by-law.

THEREFORE the council of the municipal corporation of the said township enacts as follows:

(1) The sum of \$ 7000.00 is hereby appropriated from monies raised by levy, debentures and government subsidy for total expenditure upon construction and maintenance on the roads in the said township during the year 1936 as follows:

Road Construction	\$	<u>1500.</u>
Bridge Construction	\$	<u>1000.</u>
Machinery	\$	<u>1150.</u>
Superintendence	\$	<u>350.</u>
Maintenance & Repair	\$	<u>3000.</u>
Total Estimated Expenditure	\$	<u>7000.</u>

(2) The said monies shall be expended under the direction of the duly appointed township road superintendent and on work performed in accordance with the last revised regulations respecting township roads issued by the Department of Highways of Ontario.

(3) The clerk shall transmit this by-law in duplicate to the Deputy Minister, Department of Highways, for approval on or before January 31st of the present year.

BY-LAW NO. 15

A By-Law to protect the morals of the Public in the Municipality of the Township of Georgina.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina deems it necessary to protect the morals of the Public in private and public parks and on public highways.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows:-

1. THAT it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to appear on any street or highway or in any public place in said Township, unless properly dressed or wearing a garment which is not transparent.
2. THAT it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to undress and put on bathing suits in motor cars, busses or any vehicle, in private or public parks or on the public highways of the said Township.
3. THAT any person found guilty of the violation of any of the provisions of this By-Law shall upon conviction be liable to a fine of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$20.00.

BY-LAW No. 16

TO AUTHORIZE THE BORROWING OF MONEY TO MEET CURRENT
EXPENDITURES FOR THE YEAR

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary by the Council of the Corporation of
the Township of Georgina to borrow an
amount not at any time to exceed the sum of

Four thousand dollars
to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Corporation
for the year, including the amounts for sinking fund, principal and interest falling due
within the year upon the debts of the Corporation, school purposes, special rates pur-
poses and for meeting the requirements of any Board, Commission or body and other
purposes for which the Corporation is required by law to provide.

AND WHEREAS the amount heretofore borrowed by the Corporation and
outstanding (if any) for the purposes aforesaid and the amount hereby authorized to
be borrowed do not exceed the amount which may be lawfully borrowed under Section
334 of the Municipal Act, Chapter 233, Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1927 as amended
by the Municipal Amendment Act, ~~1932 (22 George V, Chapter 29, Section 12)~~

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED ^{1933.} as a By-law by the said Council as follows:

1. That the Head and Treasurer of the said Corporation be and they are hereby authorized to borrow from The Bank of Nova Scotia an amount not at any time to exceed the sum of _____ dollars until such time as the taxes levied or to be levied shall be collected and applied to repay such advance.
2. That the said sum may be borrowed in one amount or in such sums from time to time as may be found expedient and at such rate of interest as may be agreed on between the Head and Treasurer and the said Bank.
3. That as security for the sum or sums borrowed from time to time under this By-law the Head and Treasurer are hereby authorized to give to the said Bank the promissory notes, and/or other forms of agreement of the Corporation signed by the Head and Treasurer and sealed with the seal of the Corporation as may be required by the said Bank.
4. That all the revenues of the said Corporation of whatsoever nature and kind be and the same are hereby charged to and in favour of the said Bank for and with the payment of any sum borrowed under this By-law and the interest thereon as hereinbefore provided.
5. That the Head and Treasurer be and they are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement or agreements with the said Bank sealed with the corporate seal and signed on behalf of the said Corporation by the Head and Treasurer providing for the borrowing of the sum hereby authorized and the repayment thereof on or before the last business day of the current year and containing such other terms relating to such borrowing, repayment and the charge hereby created as may be required by the said Bank.

AGREEMENT WITH MUNICIPALITY }
BORROWING BY PROMISSORY NOTE }

AGREEMENT

made this *sixth* day of *July* A.D. 19*36*,

BETWEEN THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION of the *Township*
of *Georgina* hereinafter called the "CORPORATION,"
OF THE ONE PART,

and

THE BANK OF NOVA SCOTIA, hereinafter called the "BANK,"
OF THE OTHER PART.

WHEREAS by a By-law passed by the Council of the Corporation on the *sixth*
day of *July* authority was given to the Head and Treasurer of the Corporation to borrow
from the Bank the moneys therein mentioned, and by such by-law this agreement was authorized.

AND WHEREAS the Corporation desires to borrow the said moneys on its promissory notes and the
Bank in consideration of the execution of this agreement by the Corporation has consented thereto
subject to and upon the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth.

NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED that the said moneys may be borrowed by the Head and Treasurer of
the Corporation from the Bank upon the promissory notes of the Corporation signed by the Head
and Treasurer and sealed with the seal of the Corporation.

IT IS ALSO AGREED that any moneys advanced to the Corporation from time to time upon such
promissory notes shall bear interest at the rate of _____ per cent. per annum which
shall be added at the end of each month to the amount advanced up to that time, and when added shall
for the purpose of computing subsequent interest be deemed to be part of the advance.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED that the Corporation shall repay the moneys so advanced with accrued
interest at the rate aforesaid on such date as shall be agreed with the Bank and in any event not later
than the 31st day of December next ensuing.

As security for repayment of the moneys so advanced by the Bank with interest as aforesaid, all
the revenues of the Corporation of whatever nature and kind are hereby charged to and in favour of
the Bank, and the Bank shall have a lien upon all such revenues until the charge hereby and by said
by-law created is satisfied.

AGREEMENT

BY-LAW NO. 17.

A BY-LAW requiring all persons who retail raw milk or cream in the Municipality of the Township of Georgina to have cows tested at least once a year for T.B. and also to regulate the granting of Licenses to Vendors of milk or cream for human consumption in the said Municipality.

BE IT ENACTED by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York as follows:-

1. That all persons retailing raw milk or cream in the Municipality must have cows tested at least once a year for T.B.
2. That Milk Inspector certify when test has been made and report same to Board of Health.
3. That no one shall supply or furnish milk or cream for human consumption in the said Municipality without first obtaining a License authorizing them to do so.
4. That no such License shall be granted until it has been certified by the Milk Inspector that the requirements as set forth in Sections 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 Chapter 265 R.S.O. 1927 have been complied with.
5. That the fee for such license shall be ~~as follows:-~~
one Dollar.....

6. Any Licensee who does not keep premises in accordance with Sections 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 Chapter 265 R.S.O. 1927 may have license cancelled by Milk Inspector until premises have been made according to above Sections Chapter 265 R.S.O. 1927.

BY-LAW No. 18

A By-law to authorize the borrowing of \$ 4000.00

Whereas the Council of the Township of Georgina (hereinafter called the "Municipality") deems it necessary to borrow the sum of \$ 4000.00 to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Municipality for the year;

NOTE.—Refer to the estimates for the current year if adopted; if not, to those of last year.

And Whereas the total amount of the estimated revenues of the Municipality as set forth in the estimates adopted for the year 1936, not including revenues derivable or derived from arrears of taxes, borrowings and issues of debentures is \$ 23000.00

(Delete this paragraph if not applicable).

And Whereas the total amount heretofore authorized to be borrowed this year for the purposes mentioned in subsection (1) of section 334 of The Municipal Act is \$ _____ of which the Municipality has already borrowed a total of \$ _____

PHB. R.C.W.

Therefore the Council of the Township of Georgina hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. The Head and the Treasurer are hereby authorized on behalf of the Municipality to borrow from time to time by way of promissory note from THE CANADIAN BANK OF COMMERCE a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate \$4000.00 to meet until the taxes are collected the current expenditures of the Municipality for the year, including the amounts required for the purposes mentioned in subsection (1) of the said section 334, and to give on behalf of the Municipality to the Bank a promissory note or notes sealed with the Corporate Seal and signed by the Head and Treasurer for the moneys so borrowed, with interest, which may be paid in advance or otherwise, at a rate not exceeding 5 1/2 per centum per annum.
2. All sums borrowed pursuant to the authority of this by-law as well as all other sums borrowed in this year and in previous years from the said Bank for any or all of the purposes mentioned in the said section 334, shall, with interest thereon, be a charge upon the whole of the revenues of the Municipality for the current year and for all preceding years as and when such revenues are received.
3. The Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to apply in payment of all sums borrowed as aforesaid, together with interest thereon, all of the moneys hereafter collected or received either on account or realized in respect of taxes levied for the current year and preceding years or from any other source which may lawfully be applied for such purpose.
