BY-LAW NO. 38

A BY-LAW FOR LICENSING AND REQUIRING THE REGISTRATION OF DOGS

Be it hereby enacted by the municipal council of the Township of Georgina:-

1. The owner, harbourer, or possessor of any dog within the said municipality shall procure from the corporation a tag for same and shall pay an annual license fee of Two Dollars for a dog, if only one, and Four Dollars for each additional dog, and Four Dollars for a bitch, if only one, and Six Dollars for each additional bitch owned, harboured or possessed by him, where more than one dog or bitch is owned by any one person or in any one household.
2. The Township assessor and clerk, <sup>and Treasurer.</sup> or other person appointed for the purpose shall collect the dog license fee and give the owner, harborer or possessor a tag for each dog on payment of the fee.
3. It shall be the duty of the Clerk to procure and deliver to the Assessor or other person appointed for the purpose suitable tags as required by him.
4. Each tag shall bear a serial number and the year in which it was issued and a record shall be kept by the clerk showing the name and address of the owner and the serial number of the tag.
5. All license tags under this by-law shall be procured annually on or before *April 30<sup>th</sup> each year.*
6. The assessor, Clerk or other persons authorized to collect dog license fees shall pay over to the township treasurer once in every two weeks the total amount of license fees collected during the preceding two weeks.
7. Every person procuring a tag shall keep it fixed on the dog for which it was procured at all times during the year and until he procures a tag for the following year; excepting that the tag may be removed while the dog is being lawfully used for hunting deer in the bush.
8. Every owner of a dog who neglects to obtain a tag and keep it securely fixed on his dog or who uses a tag upon a dog other than that for which it was issued shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding Ten dollars.
9. Every dog which is found off the premises upon which it is habitually kept, without a tag and not under the control of any person may be killed.
10. All by-laws or parts of by-laws conflicting with this by-law are hereby repealed.
11. This by-law shall come into force and have effect from and after the passing thereof.

A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE TOTAL 1938. EXPENDITURE ON ROADS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF Georgina IN THE COUNTY OF York

WHEREAS The Highway Improvement Act, Chapter 54, R.S.O., 1927 and amendments requires that the total expenditure on township roads and bridges be provided for annually by township by-law.

THEREFORE the council of the corporation of the said township enacts as follows:

**A By-law** to authorize the borrowing of \$ 4000.00

Whereas the Council of the Township of Georgina (hereinafter called the "Municipality") deems it necessary to borrow the sum of \$ 4000.00 to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Municipality for the year;

1. The Head and the Treasurer are hereby authorized on behalf of the Municipality to borrow from time to time by way of promissory note from THE CANADIAN BANK OF COMMERCE a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate \$ 4000.00 to meet until the taxes are collected the current expenditures of the Municipality for the year, including the amounts required for the purposes mentioned in subsection (1) of the said section 334, and to give on behalf of the Municipality to the Bank a promissory note or notes sealed with the Corporate Seal and signed by the Head and Treasurer for the moneys so borrowed, with interest, which may be paid in advance or otherwise, at a rate not exceeding 5 per centum per annum.
2. All sums borrowed pursuant to the authority of this by-law as well as all other sums borrowed in this year and in previous years from the said Bank for any or all of the purposes mentioned in the said section 334, shall, with interest thereon, be a charge upon the whole of the revenues of the Municipality for the current year and for all preceding years as and when such revenues are received.
3. The Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to apply in payment of all sums borrowed as aforesaid, together with interest thereon, all of the moneys hereafter collected or received either on account or realized in respect of taxes levied for the current year and preceding years or from any other source which may lawfully be applied for such purpose.

MUNICIPAL BORROWING BY-LAW  
FOR ORDINARY EXPENDITURE—ONTARIO }

BY-LAW No. 41

TO AUTHORIZE THE BORROWING OF MONEY TO MEET CURRENT  
EXPENDITURES FOR THE YEAR

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary by the Council of the Corporation of  
the Township of Georgina to borrow an  
amount not at any time to exceed the sum of ~~4000.00~~

Four Thousand dollars  
to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Corporation  
for the year, including the amounts for sinking fund, principal and interest falling due  
within the year upon the debts of the Corporation, school purposes, special rates pur-  
poses and for meeting the requirements of any Board, Commission or body and other  
purposes for which the Corporation is required by law to provide.

AND WHEREAS the amount heretofore borrowed by the Corporation and  
outstanding (if any) for the purposes aforesaid and the amount hereby authorized to  
be borrowed do not exceed the amount which may be lawfully borrowed under Section  
334<sup>9</sup> of the Municipal Act, Chapter 238, Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1927 as amended  
by the Municipal Amendment Act, 1933.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED as a By-law by the said Council as follows:

1. That the Head and Treasurer of the said Corporation be and they are hereby authorized  
to borrow from The Bank of Nova Scotia an amount not at any time to exceed the sum of

Four Thousand dollars  
until such time as the taxes levied or to be levied shall be collected and applied to repay such advance.

2. That the said sum may be borrowed in one amount or in such sums from time to time  
as may be found expedient and at such rate of interest as may be agreed on between the Head and  
Treasurer and the said Bank.

3. That as security for the sum or sums borrowed from time to time under this By-law the  
Head and Treasurer are hereby authorized to give to the said Bank the promissory notes, and/or  
other forms of agreement of the Corporation signed by the Head and Treasurer and sealed with the  
seal of the Corporation as may be required by the said Bank.

4. That all the revenues of the said Corporation of whatsoever nature and kind be and the  
same are hereby charged to and in favour of the said Bank for and with the payment of any sum  
borrowed under this By-law and the interest thereon as hereinbefore provided.

5. That the Head and Treasurer be and they are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement  
or agreements with the said Bank sealed with the corporate seal and signed on behalf of the said Cor-  
poration by the Head and Treasurer providing for the borrowing of the sum hereby authorized and  
the repayment thereof on or before the last business day of the current year and containing such  
other terms relating to such borrowing, repayment and the charge hereby created as may be required  
by the said Bank.

subject to and upon the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth.

NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED that the said moneys may be borrowed by the Head and Treasurer of  
the Corporation from the Bank upon the promissory notes of the Corporation signed by the Head  
and Treasurer and sealed with the seal of the Corporation.

IT IS ALSO AGREED that any moneys advanced to the Corporation from time to time upon such  
promissory notes shall bear interest at the rate of \_\_\_\_\_ per cent. per annum which  
shall be added at the end of each month to the amount advanced up to that time, and when added shall  
for the purpose of computing subsequent interest be deemed to be part of the advance.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED that the Corporation shall repay the moneys so advanced with accrued  
interest at the rate aforesaid on such date as shall be agreed with the Bank and in any event not later  
than the 31st day of December next ensuing.

As security for repayment of the moneys so advanced by the Bank with interest as aforesaid, all  
the revenues of the Corporation of whatever nature and kind are hereby charged to and in favour of  
the Bank, and the Bank shall have a lien upon all such revenues until the charge hereby and by said  
by-law created is satisfied.

TOWNSHIP OF GEORGINA

BY-LAW NUMBER 43

A BY-LAW to restrict the speed of vehicles on certain roads in the Township of Georgina.

WHEREAS Subsection 2a of Section 23 of "The Highway Traffic Act" as amended by Subsection 3 of Section 2 of "The Highway Traffic Amended Act" 1937, provides that the Council of any Township may by reason of density of population or number or proximity of buildings therein or in any part thereof by By-law approved by the Department prohibit a motor vehicle from being operated at a greater rate of speed than thirty miles per hour in the Township or in such part or parts thereof or on such highways or parts of highways as the By-law may define.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient by reason of the density of population and number and proximity of buildings adjacent thereto that speed of vehicles on certain roads in the Township of Georgina be restricted.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF GEORGINA, IN THE COUNTY OF YORK, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

(1.) No vehicle shall be driven upon the following designated Highway, in the Township of Georgina at a greater rate of speed than thirty miles per hour, that is the road known as the Hedge Road from the westerly limits of the Township of Georgina, easterly to St. George's Church, running along or near the shores of Lake Simcoe, also the road known as the Pefferlaw Road from the School House known as School Section No. 9 in the Township of Georgina, easterly to a bridge in front of Roy Corner's property Lot part 23, Concession 5, Township of Georgina.

(2) Every person who violates any of the provisions of this By-Law shall incur the penalties provided in Subsection 3 of Section 23 of "The Highway Traffic Act".

(3) The provisions of this By-law shall not become effective until Signs have been erected in compliance with the regulations of The Department of Highways.

(4) Subject to the provisions of the preceding paragraph, this By-Law shall take effect upon, from and after receiving the approval of The Department of Highways.
