

BY-LAW NO. 61.

A BY-LAW to appoint Auditors, Assessor, Collector of Taxes Members of Board of Health and Sheep Valuators for the Township of Georgina for the year 1940.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows:-

(1) That *J. T. Smethurst*<sup>x</sup> and *R. H. Corner*<sup>x</sup>..... be and are hereby appointed Auditors of the Township accounts and that they be paid for the due performance of their duties the sum of \$ *12.50*..... each.

(2) That *J. E. Taylor*<sup>x</sup>..... be and is hereby appointed Assessor for the Township of Georgina for the year 1940, and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties the sum of \$ *150.00*.....

(3) That *George Burgess*<sup>x</sup> be and is hereby appointed Collector of Taxes for the Township of Georgina for the year 1940 and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties the sum of \$ *90.00*.....

(4) That the Reeve, Clerk, *Edm. W. Harvey*<sup>x</sup> and the Medical Health Officer be and are hereby appointed a Board of Health for the Township of Georgina for the year 1940.

(5) That the following persons be and are hereby appointed Sheep Valuators in their respective Polling Sub-Divisions and that they be paid for each valuation the sum of \$ *1.50*.....

BY-LAW No. *63*

**A By-law** to authorize the borrowing of \$ *4000.00*

Whereas the Council of the *Township of Georgina* (hereinafter called the "Municipality") deems it necessary to borrow the sum of \$ *4000.00* to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Municipality for the year;

NOTE.—Refer to the estimates for the current year if adopted; if not, to those of last year.

And Whereas the total amount of the estimated revenues of the Municipality as set forth in the estimates adopted for the year 19*40*, not including revenues derivable or derived from arrears of taxes, borrowings and issues of debentures, is \$ *10000.00*

(Delete this paragraph if not applicable).

~~And Whereas the total amount heretofore authorized to be borrowed this year for the purposes mentioned in subsection (1) of section 339 of The Municipal Act is \$ \_\_\_\_\_, of which the Municipality has already borrowed a total of \$ \_\_\_\_\_~~

Therefore the Council of the *Township of Georgina* hereby enacts as follows:

1. The Head and the Treasurer are hereby authorized on behalf of the Municipality to borrow from time to time by way of promissory note from THE CANADIAN BANK OF COMMERCE a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate \$ \_\_\_\_\_ to meet until the taxes are collected the current expenditures of the Municipality for the year, including the amounts required for the purposes mentioned in subsection (1) of section 339 of the Municipal Act, and to give on behalf of the Municipality to the Bank a promissory note or notes sealed with the Corporate Seal and signed by the Head and Treasurer for the moneys so borrowed, with interest, which may be paid in advance or otherwise, at a rate not exceeding \_\_\_\_\_ per centum per annum.
2. All sums borrowed pursuant to the authority of this by-law, as well as all other sums borrowed in this year and in previous years from the said Bank for any or all of the purposes mentioned in the said section 339, shall, with interest thereon, be a charge upon the whole of the revenues of the Municipality for the current year and for all preceding years as and when such revenues are received.
3. The Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to apply in payment of all sums borrowed as aforesaid, together with interest thereon, all of the moneys hereafter collected or received either on account or realized in respect of taxes levied for the current year and preceding years or from any other source which may lawfully be applied for such purpose.

MUNICIPAL BORROWING BY-LAW FOR }  
ORDINARY EXPENDITURE—ONTARIO }

BY-LAW No. 64

TO AUTHORIZE THE BORROWING OF MONEY TO MEET CURRENT  
EXPENDITURES FOR THE YEAR

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary by the Council of the Corporation of  
the *Township* of *Georgina* to borrow an  
amount not at any time to exceed the sum of

*Four Thousand.* dollars

to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Corporation  
for the year, including the amounts for sinking fund, principal and interest falling due  
within the year upon the debts of the Corporation, school purposes, special rates pur-  
poses and for meeting the requirements of any Board, Commission or body and other  
purposes for which the Corporation is required by law to provide.

AND WHEREAS the amount heretofore borrowed by the Corporation and  
outstanding (if any) for the purposes aforesaid and the amount hereby authorized to  
be borrowed do not exceed the amount which may be lawfully borrowed under Section  
339 of the Municipal Act, Chapter 266, Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1937.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED as a By-law by the said Council as follows:

1. That the Head and Treasurer of the said Corporation be and they are hereby authorized  
to borrow from The Bank of Nova Scotia an amount not at any time to exceed the sum of

*Four Thousand.* dollars

until such time as the taxes levied or to be levied shall be collected and applied to repay such advance.

2. That the said sum may be borrowed in one amount or in such sums from time to time  
as may be found expedient and at such rate of interest as may be agreed on between the Head and  
Treasurer and the said Bank.

3. That as security for the sum or sums borrowed from time to time under this By-law the  
Head and Treasurer are hereby authorized to give to the said Bank the promissory notes, and/or  
other forms of agreement of the Corporation signed by the Head and Treasurer and sealed with the  
seal of the Corporation as may be required by the said Bank.

4. That all the revenues of the said Corporation of whatsoever nature and kind be and the  
same are hereby charged to and in favour of the said Bank for and with the payment of any sum  
borrowed under this By-law and the interest thereon as hereinbefore provided.

5. That the Head and Treasurer be and they are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement  
or agreements with the said Bank sealed with the corporate seal and signed on behalf of the said Cor-  
poration by the Head and Treasurer providing for the borrowing of the sum hereby authorized and  
the repayment thereof on or before the last business day of the current year and containing such  
other terms relating to such borrowing, repayment and the charge hereby created as may be required  
by the said Bank.

A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE TOTAL 1940 EXPENDITURE ON ROADS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF Georgina IN THE COUNTY OF York

WHEREAS The Highway Improvement Act, Chapter 56, R.S.O., 1937 and amendments requires that the total expenditure on township roads and bridges be provided for annually by township by-law.

THEREFORE the council of the corporation of the said township enacts as follows:

(1) The sum of \$ 8000.<sup>00</sup> is hereby appropriated from monies raised by levy, debentures and government subsidy for total expenditure upon construction and maintenance of the roads in the said township during the year 19 40 as follows:

(2) The said monies shall be expended under the direction of the duly appointed township road superintendent and on work performed in accordance with the latest regulations respecting township roads issued by the Department of Highways of Ontario.

(3) The clerk shall transmit a copy of this by-law to the Municipal Roads Branch, Department of Highways, for approval on or before February 28th of the present year.

That in the event of an Election being held, the said Deputy Returning Officers shall be paid \$<sup>01</sup>/<sub>4</sub>.....each, Poll Clerks \$<sup>01</sup>/<sub>3</sub>..... each and Constables when employed \$<sup>50</sup>/<sub>1</sub>.....each, for the due performance of their duties, and that \$<sup>01</sup>/<sub>2</sub>.....be allowed for each Polling Booth.
7. That all BY-LAWS or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this By-Law be and the same are hereby repealed.

To submit a Question to a vote of the municipal electors regarding the extension for one year of the term of office of members of council in office on the 1st day of February, 1941.


Pursuant to the authority vested in them by The Local Government Extension Act 1940, section 7.
