A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE TOTAL 1943 EXPENDITURE ON ROADS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF Georgina IN THE COUNTY OF York

WHEREAS The Highway Improvement Act, Chapter 56, R.S.O., 1937 and amendments requires that the total expenditure on township roads and bridges be provided for annually by township by-law.

THEREFORE the council of the corporation of the said township enacts as follows:

(1) The sum of \$ 6500. is hereby appropriated from monies raised by levy and government subsidy for total expenditure upon maintenance of the roads in the said township during the year 1943. as follows:

Superintendence	\$	<u>500.</u>
Maintenance & Repair	\$	<u>5500.</u>
Total Estimated Expenditure	\$	<u>6500.</u>

(2) The said monies shall be expended under the direction of the duly appointed township road superintendent and on work performed in accordance with the latest regulations respecting township roads issued by the Department of Highways of Ontario.

(3) The clerk shall transmit a copy of this by-law to the Municipal Roads Branch, Department of Highways, for approval on or before February 28th of the present year.
