

BY-LAW NO. 152

A BY-LAW to appoint Auditor, Assessor, Collector of Taxes Members of the Board of Health and Sheep Valutors for the Township of Georgina for the year 1948.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York enacts as follows:

- (1) That E. P. MacGee be and is hereby appointed Auditor for the Township of Georgina for the year 1948, and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties the sum of \$ 135.00....
- (2) That J. E. Taylor be and is hereby appointed Assessor for the Township of Georgina for the year 1948, and that he be paid for the due performance of his duties the sum of \$ 400.00....

A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE TOTAL 1948 EXPENDITURE ON ROADS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF Georgina IN THE COUNTY DISTRICT OF York

WHEREAS The Highway Improvement Act, Chapter 56, R.S.O., 1937 and amendments requires that the total expenditure on township roads and bridges be provided for annually by township by-law.

THEREFORE the council of the corporation of the said township enacts as follows:

(1) The sum of \$ 41,700. is hereby appropriated from monies raised by levy, debentures and government subsidy for total expenditure upon construction and maintenance of the roads and bridges under its jurisdiction during the year 1948 as follows:

BY-LAW NO. 157

A By-law to prohibit the obstruction of highways and to prohibit throwing dirt, glass, etc., on highways, and to prohibit the obstruction of ditches or culverts upon highways.

Be it enacted by the Municipal Council for the Corporation of the Township of Georgina:

1. No person shall obstruct, encumber, injure or foul any highway or bridge under the jurisdiction or control of the Township of Georgina.

2. No person shall throw, place or deposit on any highway or bridge under the jurisdiction or control of the Township of Georgina any dirt, filth, glass, hand-bill, paper or other rubbish or refuse or the carcass of any animal.

3. No person shall obstruct any ditch or culvert upon any highway under the jurisdiction or control of the Township of Georgina.

4. Any person convicted of a breach of any of the provisions of this by-law shall forfeit and pay, at the discretion of the convicting magistrate, a penalty not exceeding (inclusive of costs) the sum of FIFTY DOLLARS(\$50.00) for each offence.

BY-LAW NO. 158

TOWNSHIP OF GEORGINA

A By-Law to restrict the speed of vehicles on certain roads in the Township of Georgina.

WHEREAS Subsection 2a of Section 23 of "The Highway Traffic Act" as amended by Subsection 3 of Section 2 of "The Highway Traffic Amended Act" 1937, provides that the Council of any Township may by reason of density of population or number or proximity of buildings therein or in any part thereof by By-Law approved by the Department prohibit a motor vehicle from being operated at a greater rate of speed than thirty miles per hour in the Township or in such part or parts thereof or on such highways as the By-Law may define.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient by reason of a dangerous railway crossing, the density of population and number and proximity of buildings adjacent thereto that speed of vehicles on certain roads in the Township of Georgina be restricted.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF GEORGINA, IN THE COUNTY OF YORK, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. No vehicle shall be driven upon the following designated highway in the Township of Georgina at a greater rate of speed than thirty miles per hour, that is the road known as the Eighth Concession of the Township of Georgina, running westerly from the Brock Townline to Mr. E. G. Corner's Park on Lake Simcoe.
2. Every person who violates any of the provisions of this By-Law shall incur the penalties provided in Subsection 3 of Section 23 of "The Highway Traffic Act".
3. The provisions of this By-Law shall not become effective until signs have been erected in compliance with the regulations of the Department of Highways.
4. Subject to the provisions of the preceding paragraph, this By-Law shall take effect upon, from and after receiving the approval of the Department of Highways.

A By-Law to restrict the speed of vehicles on certain roads in the Township of Georgina.

WHEREAS Subsection 2a of Section 23 of "The Highway Traffic Act" as amended by Subsection 3 of Section 2 of "The Highway Traffic Amended Act" 1937, provides that the Council of any Township may be reason of density of population or number or proximity of buildings therein or in any part thereof by By-Law approved by the Department prohibit a motor vehicle from being operated at a greater rate of speed than thirty miles per hour in the Township or in such part or parts thereof or on such highways as the By-Law may define.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient by reason of the density of population and number and proximity of buildings adjacent thereto that speed of vehicles on certain roads in the Township of Georgina be restricted.

2. Every person who violates any of the Provisions of this By-Law shall incur the penalties provided in Subsection 3 of Section 23 of "The Highway Traffic Act".
3. The provisions of this By-Law shall not become effective until signs have been erected in compliance with the regulations of the Department of Highways.
4. Subject to the provisions of the preceding paragraph, this By-Law shall take effect upon, from and after receiving the approval of the Department of Highways.

4. Subject to the provisions of the preceding paragraph this By-Law shall take effect upon, from and after receiving the approval of the Department of Highways.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient by reason of the density of population and number and proximity of buildings adjacent thereto that speed of vehicles on certain roads in the Township of Georgina be restricted.

4. Subject to the provisions of the preceding paragraph this By-Law shall take effect upon, from and after receiving the approval of the Department of Highways.

BY-LAW NO. 163
