A BY-LAW to appoint Auditor, Assessor, Collector of Taxes Members of Board of Health and Sheep Valuators for the Township of Georgina Township for the year 1949.

(4) That the Reeve, Clerk, Allan Snaddon and the Medical Health Officer be and are hereby appointed a Board of Health for the Township of Georgina for the year 1949.

(5) That the following persons be and are hereby appointed Sheep Valuators in their respective Polling Sub-Divisions and that they be paid for each valuation the sum of \$ 2.00

(6) That all BY-LAWS or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this BY-LAW be and the same are hereby repealed.

BY-LAW No. 167

**A By-law** to authorize the borrowing of \$ 20,000.00

Whereas the Council of the *Township of Georgina* (hereinafter called the "Municipality") deems it necessary to borrow the sum of \$ 20,000.00 to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Municipality for the year;

NOTE.—Refer to the estimates for the current year if adopted; if not, to those of last year.

And Whereas the total amount of the estimated revenues of the Municipality as set forth in the estimates adopted for the year 1949, not including revenues derivable or derived from arrears of taxes, borrowings and issues of debentures, is \$ 45,000.00

~~And Whereas the total amount heretofore authorized to be borrowed this year for the purposes mentioned in subsection (1) of section 339 of The Municipal Act is \$ \_\_\_\_\_, of which the Municipality has already borrowed a total of \$ \_\_\_\_\_~~

Therefore the Council of the *Township of Georgina* hereby enacts as follows:

1. The Head and the Treasurer are hereby authorized on behalf of the Municipality to borrow from time to time by way of promissory note from THE CANADIAN BANK OF COMMERCE a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate \$ 20,000.00 to meet until the taxes are collected the current expenditures of the Municipality for the year, including the amounts required for the purposes mentioned in subsection (1) of section 339 of the Municipal Act, and to give on behalf of the Municipality to the Bank a promissory note or notes sealed with the Corporate Seal and signed by the Head and Treasurer for the moneys so borrowed, with interest, which may be paid in advance or otherwise, at a rate not exceeding  $4\frac{1}{2}$  per centum per annum.
2. All sums borrowed pursuant to the authority of this by-law, as well as all other sums borrowed in this year and in previous years from the said Bank for any or all of the purposes mentioned in the said section 339, shall, with interest thereon, be a charge upon the whole of the revenues of the Municipality for the current year and for all preceding years as and when such revenues are received.
3. The Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to apply in payment of all sums borrowed as aforesaid, together with interest thereon, all of the moneys hereafter collected or received either on account or realized in respect of taxes levied for the current year and preceding years or from any other source which may lawfully be applied for such purpose.

MUNICIPAL BORROWING BY-LAW FOR }  
ORDINARY EXPENDITURE—ONTARIO }

BY-LAW No. 168 .....

TO AUTHORIZE THE BORROWING OF MONEY TO MEET CURRENT  
EXPENDITURES FOR THE YEAR

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary by the Council of the Corporation of  
the *Township* of *Georgina* to borrow an  
amount not at any time to exceed the sum of

*Ten Thousand* dollars

to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Corporation  
for the year, including the amounts for sinking fund, principal and interest falling due  
within the year upon the debts of the Corporation, school purposes, special rates pur-  
poses and for meeting the requirements of any Board, Commission or body and other  
purposes for which the Corporation is required by law to provide.

AND WHEREAS the amount heretofore borrowed by the Corporation and  
outstanding (if any) for the purposes aforesaid and the amount hereby authorized to  
be borrowed do not exceed the amount which may be lawfully borrowed under Section  
339 of the Municipal Act, Chapter 266, Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1937.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED as a By-law by the said Council as follows:

1. That the Head and Treasurer of the said Corporation be and they are hereby authorized  
to borrow from The Bank of Nova Scotia an amount not at any time to exceed the sum of  
*ten thousand* dollars  
until such time as the taxes levied or to be levied shall be collected and applied to repay such advance.

2. That the said sum may be borrowed in one amount or in such sums from time to time  
as may be found expedient and at such rate of interest as may be agreed on between the Head and  
Treasurer and the said Bank.

3. That as security for the sum or sums borrowed from time to time under this By-law the  
Head and Treasurer are hereby authorized to give to the said Bank the promissory notes, and/or  
other forms of agreement of the Corporation signed by the Head and Treasurer and sealed with the  
seal of the Corporation as may be required by the said Bank.

4. That all the revenues of the said Corporation of whatsoever nature and kind be and the  
same are hereby charged to and in favour of the said Bank for and with the payment of any sum  
borrowed under this By-law and the interest thereon as hereinbefore provided.

5. That the Head and Treasurer be and they are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement  
or agreements with the said Bank sealed with the corporate seal and signed on behalf of the said Cor-  
poration by the Head and Treasurer providing for the borrowing of the sum hereby authorized and  
the repayment thereof on or before the last business day of the current year and containing such  
other terms relating to such borrowing, repayment and the charge hereby created as may be required  
by the said Bank.

# AGREEMENT

made this *seventh* day of *February* 19*49*,

BETWEEN THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION of the *Township*  
of *Georgina* hereinafter called the "CORPORATION,"

OF THE ONE PART,

and

THE BANK OF NOVA SCOTIA, hereinafter called "The Bank,"

OF THE OTHER PART.

WHEREAS by a By-law passed by the Council of the Corporation on the *seventh*  
day of *February* 19*49* authority was given to the Head and Treasurer of the Corporation  
to borrow from the Bank the moneys therein mentioned, and by such by-law this agreement was  
authorized.

AND WHEREAS the Corporation desires to borrow the said moneys on its promissory notes and the  
Bank in consideration of the execution of this agreement by the Corporation has consented thereto  
subject to and upon the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth.

NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED that the said moneys may be borrowed by the Head and Treasurer of  
the Corporation from the Bank upon the promissory notes of the Corporation signed by the Head  
and Treasurer and sealed with the seal of the Corporation.

IT IS ALSO AGREED that any moneys advanced to the Corporation from time to time upon such  
promissory notes shall bear interest at the rate of  $4\frac{1}{2}$  per cent. per annum which  
shall be added at the end of each month to the amount advanced up to that time, and when added shall  
for the purpose of computing subsequent interest be deemed to be part of the advance.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED that the Corporation shall repay the moneys so advanced with accrued  
interest at the rate aforesaid on such date as shall be agreed with the Bank and in any event not later  
than the 31st day of December next ensuing.

As security for repayment of the moneys so advanced by the Bank with interest as aforesaid, all  
the revenues of the Corporation of whatever nature and kind are hereby charged to and in favour of  
the Bank, and the Bank shall have a lien upon all such revenues until the charge hereby and by said  
by-law created is satisfied.

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A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE TOTAL 1949 EXPENDITURE ON ROADS IN THE TOWNSHIP

OF Georgina IN THE COUNTY OF York

WHEREAS The Highway Improvement Act, Chapter 56, R.S.O., 1937 and amendments requires that the total expenditure on township roads and bridges be provided for annually by township by-law.

THEREFORE the council of the corporation of the said township enacts as follows:

(1) The sum of \$ 54,700.00 is hereby appropriated from monies raised by levy, debentures and government subsidy for total expenditure upon construction and maintenance of the roads and bridges under its jurisdiction during the year 19 as follows:

(3) The clerk shall transmit duplicate copies of this by-law to the district office of the Municipal Roads Branch, Department of Highways, on or before February 28th of the present year.


**WHEREAS** it is expedient that an agreement be entered into with
