CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF GEORGINA

BY-LAW No. 181

A By-law to authorize the borrowing of \$ 25,000.

Whereas the Council of the Township of Georgina (hereinafter called the "Municipality") deems it necessary to borrow the sum of \$ 25,000 to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Municipality for the year;

And Whereas the total amount of the estimated revenues of the Municipality as set forth in the estimates adopted for the year 19 50, not including revenues derivable or derived from arrears of taxes, borrowings and issues of debentures, is \$ 53,000

NOTE.—Refer to the estimates for the current year if adopted; if not, to those of last year.

Therefore the Council of the Township of Georgina hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. The Head and the Treasurer are hereby authorized on behalf of the Municipality to borrow from time to time by way of promissory note from THE CANADIAN BANK OF COMMERCE a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate \$ 25,000, to meet until the taxes are collected the current expenditures of the Municipality for the year, including the amounts required for the purposes mentioned in subsection (1) of section 339 of the Municipal Act, and to give on behalf of the Municipality to the Bank a promissory note or notes sealed with the Corporate Seal and signed by the Head and Treasurer for the moneys so borrowed, with interest, which may be paid in advance or otherwise, at a rate not exceeding 4 1/2 per centum per annum.
- 2. All sums borrowed pursuant to the authority of this by-law, as well as all other sums borrowed in this year and in previous years from the said Bank for any or all of the purposes mentioned in the said section 339, shall, with interest thereon, be a charge upon the whole of the revenues of the Municipality for the current year and for all preceding years as and when such revenues are received.
- 3. The Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to apply in payment of all sums borrowed as aforesaid, together with interest thereon, all of the moneys hereafter collected or received either on account or realized in respect of taxes levied for the current year and preceding years or from any other source which may lawfully be applied for such purpose.

A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE TOTAL 1950 EXPENDITURE ON ROADS IN THE TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS The Highway Improvement Act, Chapter 56, R.S.O., 1937 and amendments requires that the total expenditure on township roads and bridges be provided for annually by township by-law.

THEREFORE the council of the corporation of the said township enacts as follows:

(1) The sum of \$ 42,200. is hereby appropriated from monies raised by levy, debentures and government subsidy for total expenditure upon construction and maintenance of the roads and bridges under its jurisdiction during the year 1950 as follows:

The Corporation of the Township of GEORGINA

A By-law to authorize the Corporation to enter into an agreement with The Hydro-Electric Power Commission of Ontario for street lighting.

WHEREAS a majority of the resident freeholders according to the last revised assessment roll residing within the area described in the petition have petitioned the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Georgina to procure from The Hydro-Electric Power Commission of Ontario, street lighting in the said area, and the said petition was accompanied by the certificate of the Clerk of the Township stating that it was signed by a majority of the said resident freeholders;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to such petition the Council of the said Township have requested The Hydro-Electric Power Commission of Ontario to supply electrical power or energy for that purpose; and The Hydro-Electric Power Commission of Ontario has furnished estimates of the cost thereof;

AND WHEREAS notice was duly given to each of the petitioners signing the said petition that the Council of the Township would at a special meeting called for that purpose consider the said estimates;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the said Township at such meeting held within one month after the delivery of said estimates, namely on the 12th day of December, 1949, considered the said estimates, and heard the petitioners;

AND WHEREAS at the close of the said meeting there were remaining on the petition a sufficient number of names to constitute

a majority of the resident freeholders within the said area;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF GEORGINA enacts as follows:-

1. THAT the Corporation of the Township of Georgina do enter into an agreement with The Hydro-Electric Power Commission of Ontario for street lighting in the said area, a copy of which agreement is hereto attached and forms part of this By-law;
2. THAT the Reeve and Clerk of the Corporation be and they are hereby authorized and required to execute the said agreement on behalf of the Corporation and to affix the Corporate Seal there-to and to deliver such agreement when executed to The Hydro-Electric Power Commission of Ontario;
3. THAT 50 % of the cost incurred under said agreement for street lighting in the area therein described be raised, levied and collected by an annual special rate upon the taxable property lying within the said area;
4. THAT 50 % of the cost incurred under the said agreement for street lighting in the area therein described be paid by the Corporation and be chargeable to the municipality as a whole.

BY-LAW NO. 191

A By-law to regulate and license all Public Dance Halls and all places of amusement, and for revoking any license granted.

WHEREAS pursuant to Chapter 233, section 429, paragraph 2 of the Revised Statutes of the Province of Ontario 1927 and amendments thereto, power is given to this Municipality to regulate and license Public Dance Halls and places of amusement,

THEREFORE be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Township of Georgina in the County of York as follows:-

THAT the said Municipality is hereby empowered to regulate and to license all Dance Halls erected or operating within the limits of the said Municipality.

BEFORE any Dance Hall shall commence operations or shall continue to operate, it shall apply for a license permitting it to do so.

The fee for said license shall be as follows:-
Accommodation for up to 300 persons \$10.00; from 300 to 600 persons \$20.00; over 600 persons \$50.00 per calendar year which shall be paid before said license shall be granted and, until said license is granted, said Dance Hall shall not commence operations or shall not continue to operate.

THAT it shall be unlawful for any Dance Hall to operate at any time excepting between the hours of 7 a.m. and the hour of midnight following thereafter, unless permission in writing is first obtained from said Municipality or its duly appointed officer or officers.

THAT it shall be unlawful for any band, orchestra or any member or members thereof to play or practise upon any musical instrument on or about the premises of said Dance Hall excepting between the hours of eleven and twelve in the forenoon of any day, without permission in writing first being obtained from said Municipality or its duly authorized officer or officers.

Any license granted under this By-Law may be revoked or cancelled by said Municipality at any time for any reason or cause whatsoever.

Any person who contravenes the provisions of this By-Law or any part thereof, shall be forthwith liable to a fine not exceeding \$50.00 recoverable under the Summary Conviction Act of Ontario.

THAT all By-Laws or parts of By-Laws inconsistent with this By-Law be and are hereby repealed.
